Hello, parents and guardians!

We got through all of our fall MAP testing! Those test results should be mailed out this week (first week in November) detailing what your student's scores mean. Remember that we use these scores to see which students need learning support and where they need that support. Please let us know if you have any questions at all about your student's scores or the family report that is being mailed to you. Our next round of MAP testing is in January. The goal for that round is to show "learning growth." Basically, we want to see scores that are higher than their fall scores. As long as there is improvement, we know your student is learning.
