Tiffany Larsen: Digital Citizenship

- Tiffany went over the DESK standards of digital citizenship. Tiffany shared what she is teaching in the computer prep class to go over digital citizenship.

Taylor Anderton: Acadience Data

- Taylor shared the school wide data last year for Acadience Reading. Layton Elementary had a 5% proficiency growth from the beginning of the year to the end of the year. Taylor explained that she is our Literacy Coach to help teachers with their Tier I instruction. Taylor also shared the data that we have so far this year from the beginning of the year data. SPIRE, 95% Groups Phonics Program for K-3, DSD planning guides, and coaching engaging in Impact Cycle are all in place to give support in reading.

Biffy Turner: Short STEM Showcase

- Biffy shared what she is doing in the Imagination and Creativity Lab. Each class (1-6) comes to STEM lab once per month for a 45-minute STEM lesson and activity. Biffy's goal is to inspire curiosity, wonder, and learning through hands-on STEM activities that align to the DESK standards. We got a hydroponics grant, so the students will learn how to grow plants without soil. Biffy gave a little introduction to this month's lesson on the International Space Station.
