

UNIFORM TREATMENT OF RECRUITERS

Subject to the provisions of law, all recruiters, including commercial, military and nonmilitary concerns and recruiters representing institutions of high education, shall be provided the same directory information concerning, and shall be given equal opportunities of access to, students enrolled in the district's schools. Access may be granted through programs conducted by the Guidance Department. Such programs may consist of career days, college fairs, individual school visitations, and in-school recruiting. These must be held during student free time, which include lunch and study halls.
