- Commitment to continuously upgrade skills in research-based and validated practices in the field of education, MTSS, behavior, community resources and technology
- Possess ability to design and deliver professional development to educators, school support staff, parents and related service providers, administrators and agency personnel

The ideal candidate will have knowledge and expertise in the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) as it relates to students with moderate to significant intellectual disabilities, and understanding of how to implement behavioral strategies and interventions for students on the behavior continuum within the framework of the Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS), an in depth knowledge and understanding of the

Florida Standards Access Points, an understanding of inclusion in the general education setting and the use of accommodations and modifications to support general and special education teachers to meet the needs of students with disabilities. Assist districts with on-going needs assessments as it pertains to providing technical assistance with classroom consultation, observations, collaboration, coaching and feedback on areas of instruction, behavior, curriculum, including implementing Universal Design for Learning (UDL) principles. Plan, conduct/facilitate meetings, professional development, conferences, coaching sessions and/or other school or district related professional learning opportunities. The ability to conduct research, and apply research-based and validated best practices and professional development to train and coach others.
