

NOTICE OF NONDISCRIMINATION

The Town of West Hartford is committed to ensuring that no person, on the basis of, race, color, religion, ethnicity, national origin, ancestry, sex, age, sexual orientation, genetic information, gender identity/expression, marital status, citizenship, veteran status, disability, or any other protected status, be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination in any Town program, services, or activities in accordance with all state and federal civil rights laws and regulations. Any person who believes that they have been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice in accordance with applicable law, may file a complaint with the Town of West Hartford Office of Equity Advancement, no later than one hundred eighty (180) calendar days after the date of the alleged occurrence or when the alleged discrimination became known to the complainant.
