

SRVCA Resource Program

Kindergarten – 8th Grade

SRVCA is blessed to have developed a resource program that is available to students who have received a formal diagnosis of a mild/moderate learning disability with an IEP or 504 plan. A specific learning disability most often affects skills in reading, writing, listening, speaking, reasoning and math.

After an application, copy of diagnosis, and classroom documents/references are submitted, our Resource Specialist will conduct an assessment of the student to determine whether our program would be appropriate to meet the needs of the student.

Fast Facts

- Meet in specially equipped resource rooms with credentialed teachers who are gifted in Resource teaching and help.
- Students must have a professional diagnosis with an accompanying plan. (504/IEP/SST)
- Students in junior high attend **Resource** in place of Spanish.
- Students in grades K-5 attend the **Resource** in place of one or more of their enrichment classes.
- This program is designed to help each child access curriculum according to their needs.

Highlights

- Instruction designed to the specific needs of the child's differentiated learning style.
- Work with children's teachers to help accommodate the child's accommodation plans to the best of our resources.
- Assistance with learning strategies, organization, and study skills
- Work closely with school districts, attend IEP meetings and coordinate assessments
- Maintain regular communication and feedback with parents.
