

STUDENTS**Photographs of Students**

Photographs of students are education records subject to the confidentiality provisions of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). The United States Department of Education views student photographs as educational records that may be considered 'directory information.' Absent parental objection, directory information may be disclosed without obtaining prior consent. Photographs of students may be taken while they are in class or engaged in other educational-related activities and may appear in classrooms, hallways, the yearbook, school newspapers and other publications, and on the district's Internet web site. Parents objecting to such uses of photographs of their children must return a written objection to their children's school administration at the beginning of each school year.
