Instructional Material

The Board of Education recognizes the value of appropriate education materials, media, tools, and resources in the implementation of instructional practices and educational programs.

The Superintendent and staff will make efforts to equip and maintain district schools such that appropriate comparable materials are available to all students where possible within existing financial constraints.

The teaching staff, District Curriculum Committee, and support staff shall consult with Superintendent or Administrative staff regarding improvements, suggestions, and recommendations regarding materials, resources and equipment to support instruction.

Large scale textbook or instruction material plans shall be presented to the Board for adoption prior to implementation by either the Superintendent or the District Curriculum Team.
