# Graduation Requirements

- ★ 4 English
- ★ 3 Social Studies (*Gov, US History, World History*)
- ★ 3 Science (*Conceptual Physics, Chemistry, Biology*)
- ★ 4 Math (*Algebra I, Geometry and 2 additional courses*)
- ★ 1 Health
- ★ 1 PE
- ★ 1 Fine Arts
- ★ 1 Technology
- ★ ½ Financial Literacy
- ★ 2 credits of the same world language OR an approved Career and Technological Education Completer Program
- ★
  - ★ *Minimum of 25 credits and 75 service learning hours*
    - *12 credits by end of 10th grade to be promoted*
    - *18 credits by end of 11th grade + 55 Service Learning hours to be promoted to senior status*



# Did you know?

- ★ You need to apply for programs at the Career & Tech Center by **December 1st**.
- ★ You can earn certifications and/or college credits for coursework in a complete program.
- ★ To be eligible for acceptance into the programs at CCCTC, you need to have good grades and attendance. *Programs are competitive!*

# AP Classes

- ★ The AP program offers college level courses you can take in high school
- ★ To earn college credit, you must take a test in May and meet a minimum score
- ★ Courses are available in English, Social Studies, Science, math, computer science, world languages, art, and music
- ★ Juniors may start the AP Capstone Diploma Program

# Dual Enrollment Classes

- ★ Classes offered through Carroll Community College to earn college credit
- ★ Discounted classes as a high school student
- ★ Classes offered at South Carroll, at Carroll Community College and online
- ★ Classes may be graduation requirements or electives
