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HOW DO I QUALIFY FOR THE COURSE?

- **ID and Social Security Card** or Individual Tax ID Number must be provided at time of registration.
- Name on **ID and Social Security Card** or Individual Tax ID Number **MUST match**.
- Course includes theory and clinical training, course supplies, and fingerprinting fees.
- **Must attend orientation** to complete enrollment.
- Must show proof of COVID-19 vaccine and boosters within 6 months
- Need to pass:
 - Background Check
 - Proof of a negative tuberculosis immunization or chest x-ray
 - Physical exam
 - **MUST pass the CNA Entrance Exam with 70% or better**

Course Requirements and Expectations:

Classroom Time:

- * Patient Care
- * Vitals, Screenings, Procedures, Etiquette
- * Theory and Clinical
- * Skills check-off

Hands-on Learning: Students are expected to be interactive throughout the course.

Clinical Hours: Students are required to complete 100 clinical hours in a Skilled Nursing Facility, making students eligible to take the state CNA exam after successful completion of the course.

Course Includes: Theory and Clinical training, textbook, skills workbook, uniform, and fingerprinting fee.
