The Early Years to Grade Five elementary music continuums of knowledge and skills allows for differentiation in response to the wide range of student abilities. The ES Music Teacher employs a variety of instructional practices. These include vocal, instrumental, movement and literacy. This position works as a part of the Performance Art group and incorporate dance, theater and music into each child's life. A coordinated effort and support in developing drama-related activities is important.

- 4. Focusing on developing the singing voice and increasing awareness of pitch accuracy, and teaching proper vocal technique (breathing, support, phonation)
- 5. Building on experiences with harmony through singing rounds, partner songs, counter melodies, ostinatos, and two-part music
- 6. Providing teaching in drama and opportunities for performance through the Performance Arts teachers directing musicals, productions or other performance-related experiences
- 7. Organizing all-school concerts for Uniting Nations Day and Arts Festival, and hosting Parent Gamelan Visit during music classes
- 8. Coordinating and leading choir for upper elementary
- 9. Promoting appreciation and understanding of a variety of musical styles from different cultures
- 10. Studying Javanese gamelan and angklung and teaching it to students
- 11. Offering choir, musical performance and/or other performances
- 12. Striving to integrate music into the lives of children and their experiences; reinforcing subject material learned in the classroom
- 13. Embracing the JIS Learning Dispositions of Resilience, Resourcefulness, Relating and Reflectiveness
