- C. PRESENTATIONS

- C1 Jeff Caivano, Northeastern Board of Education Representative to the Springfield-Clark Career Technology Center (CTC)

Mr. Caivano provided an executive director package to the Board and told them to contact him if they have any questions. Dr. Kronour asked Mr. Caivano what was the expected enrollment for the 18-19 school year. Mr. Caivano says that the CTC still has some more tenth grade tours and he will have more information at a later time.

- C2 Belinda Banks, Curriculum Director, on the progress of the Social Studies/Foreign Language Curriculum update

Mrs. Banks talked to the Board on the sixth grade through twelfth grade social studies and eighth through twelfth grade foreign language curriculum updates. The social studies curriculum has not been updated since 2005 and the foreign language curriculum not since 1996. She reported that Spanish V is going to be added and that she and the curriculum committee are in the final stages of selecting textbooks, workbooks, etc. She expects to report final costs to the Board in the near future.

- D. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Jim Templeton, Instrumental Music/Band Director at Kenton Ridge High School, asked the Board to consider the music, choir, and vocal departments when considering which high school would be the consolidated high school. He said Kenton Ridge High School can accommodate approximately three-hundred students and offer several programs (a greater capacity than Northeastern High School). He added that the Kenton Ridge Marching Band currently has over two-hundred uniforms to accommodate any additional marching band students from Northeastern High School.

Linda Jordan, Clark County Educational Service Center board member and local resident, informed the Board about the Ohio School Boards Association (OSBA) spring conference and invited them to participate. She also informed them of the two day Board Leadership Institute through the OSBA.

Eric Barga, 2013 graduate of Kenton Ridge High School, spoke in favor of the Kenton Ridge High School music, choir, and vocal programs. He would like to reiterate Mr. Templeton's position that Kenton Ridge High School would be better for these programs if the high schools are consolidated.

Reverend Ken Woody, parent of two graduates and a senior student at Kenton Ridge High School, also supports Kenton Ridge as the consolidated high school and echoed Mr. Templeton's and Mr. Barga's comments.

Sarah Whaley, 1995 graduate of Kenton Ridge High School, also supports Kenton Ridge as the high school if consolidation has to take place.

At this time the Board began discussion on the consolidation plans submitted by Dr. Kronour and the administrative team. The four plans devised all had approximate savings of 1.1 million to 1.2 million per year with various operational/educational pros and cons. Dr. Kronour and the administrative team recommended plan B which is to close Rolling Hills Elementary. The remaining buildings would be consolidated into one middle school (Northeastern building), two elementary schools (Northridge and South Vienna buildings), and one high school (Kenton Ridge building). Based upon the Board's request, Dr. Kronour also submitted a plan that had Kenton Ridge building as a middle school and the Northeastern building as the high school.

The Board was unanimous that if the levy failed, there had to be some kind of consolidation of resources. The Board also expressed their concerns over the angst the community is feeling over planned consolidation, however, declining enrollment necessitates that the Board prepare a contingent plan.
