Welcome to the second week of our new school year! We are so excited to be back from our short break. Next week, September 12th, we begin NWEA Testing and we want to ensure that your scholars are prepared and well rested! **Important:**

Each student is required to have a mask. Please ensure that your scholars have a mask each and every day! As it is a part of their uniforms.

- Please be sure to take a look in your scholars purple folder to fill out emergency contact sheets
- Parents, Primary Students K-2 should be dropped off at Door #5 between 7:50 am and 8:05 am. Kindergarten should also be dropped off at 7:50 am at door #5. Staff members are there to greet them daily and ensure they are given direction to their classrooms. Teachers are on post in the hallway to greet our scholars as well.
- Any student arriving after 8:05 am must enter the building through the Main Office (Door #1).

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What is NWEA MAP?

- NWEA = NorthWest Evaluation Association
- Assessments
 - MAP = Measures of Academic Progress (Grades 2-8)
- Subjects
 - Math, Reading (Grades 2-8)

NWEA Testing begins the week of September 12th Students can begin preparing. The NWEA MAP Test (Measures of Academic Progress) is an adaptive achievement and growth test. It creates a personalized assessment experience by adapting to each student's learning level— precisely measuring progress and growth for each individual student. If your child correctly answers a MAP question, the computer assessment provides a harder question next. If they miss that same question, then an easier MAP question is asked. This provides essential information about what your child knows and is ready to learn.

PBIS

PBIS stands for positive behavior intervention support. This is our behavior support system at DEPSA where students have rules, rewards, and consequences. We celebrate our students for meeting the behavioral expectations. When students follow all of their classroom procedures and school rules, teachers and staff reward points on Class Dojo. When students earn enough points, they get rewarded at the end of the month with class parties or other rewards for good behavior. Students who meet behavior expectations will participate in PBIS activity Friday, September 30, 2022.

Character Camp

For the first two weeks of school students will participate in Character Camp. Character Camp is facilitated by teachers. The focus is on building strong systems and structures in our classrooms through Character Camp, where our students will practice NPFE structures and systems, teambuilding, school expectations, and work to build strong relationships with their teachers and classmates. Our goal is to build strong systems and structures so that students are ready to focus on academic learning.

Before School/After School Enrichment:

Enrichment is offered before school and after school. The annual registration fee plus one week's tuition must be paid in advance for your child to attend and participate in the enrichment program.
