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

# What is NWEA MAP?

- NWEA = NorthWest Evaluation Association
- Assessments
  - MAP = Measures of Academic Progress (Grades 2-8)
- Subjects
  - Math, Reading (Grades 2-8)

**NWEA Testing begins the week of September 6**<sup>th</sup>**. The NWEA MAP Test (Measures of Academic Progress)** is an adaptive achievement and growth test. It creates a personalized assessment experience by adapting to each student's learning level—precisely measuring progress and growth for each individual student. If your child correctly answers a MAP question, the computer assessment provides a harder question next. If they miss that same question, then an easier MAP question is asked. This provides essential information about what your child knows and is ready to learn.

### **Character Camp**

For the first two weeks of school students will participate in Character Camp. Character Camp is facilitated by teachers. The focus is on building strong systems and structures in our classrooms through Character Camp, where our students will practice NPFE structures and systems, teambuilding, school expectations, and work to build strong relationships with their teachers and classmates. Our goal is to build strong systems and structures so that students are ready to focus on academic learning.
