## Important Dates & Information: District Testing: NWEA new testing dates

- Beginning Monday, September 12, 2022, students will participate in Fall NWEA MAP testing.
- MAP stands for Measures of Academic Progress and is a standardized test that provides information on academic skills students have acquired during a school year.
- Our students take the test in Reading three times a year (Fall, Winter, Spring) and twice a year in Math (Fall, Spring).
- Students will then be placed in reading groups to receive targeting instruction to develop and increase

# **NPFE Annual Goals**

- **NWEA-** 60% or more of our students will meet their NWEA GOALS fall to spring targets in both reading and math
- **M-Step/PSAT-** proficiency will increase in both ELA and Math by 20% for grades 3-10
- Attendance Goals- Average daily attendance will be at 95% by June 2023; Chronic absenteeism will decrease by 15% in comparison to the 2021-2022 school year
- Intervention- Student usage will average 8% or higher during scheduled intervention time
- **Coaching Cycle-** Leaders will complete a minimum of 8 complete coaching cycles per teacher during the 2022-2023 school year

**Dismissal:** Student dismissal begins at 3:30pm. Students will dismiss out of Door #5 (Kindergarten dismissed out of cafeteria doors). Please make sure that you complete the emergency contact form with current information.

Late Pick Up: Late pick up begins 15 minutes after dismissal. All K-5 students are required to remain in the building after dismissal for safety reasons. Late pick up students are held in the cafeteria and parents are charged a \$20.00 late pick up fee.

**Enrichment Program:** Enrichment is offered before and after school. The annual registration fee plus one week's tuition must be paid in advance for your child to attend and participate in the enrichment program. Applications can be obtained from the main office.
