Attendance Policy

NPFE believes that punctuality and consistent on time attendance is a significant factor in academic achievement. Regular attendance to school and in classes is of vital importance if a student is to succeed in school.

- Parents are required to call in the day of a student's absence and/or send in a note upon their return.
- The State of Michigan allows students to miss a total of 10 days per school year
- Students absent 3 consecutive days are required to return to school with a doctor's note
- Students who are absent 10 consecutive days will be dropped from the roster if no parent communication has occurred with school
