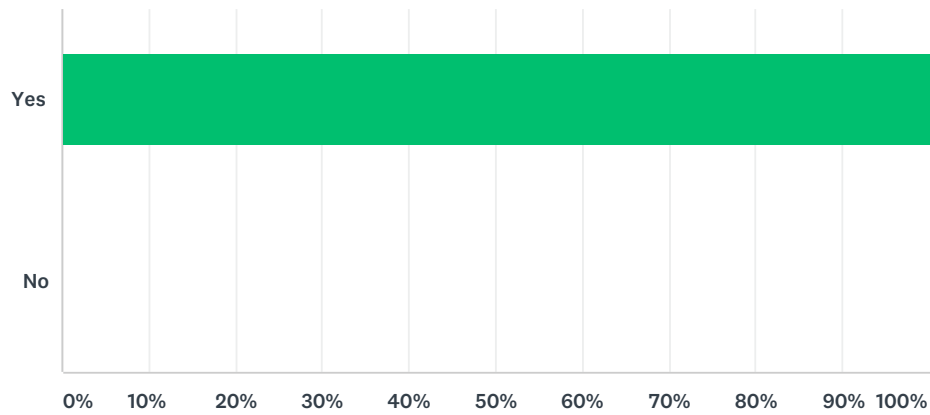

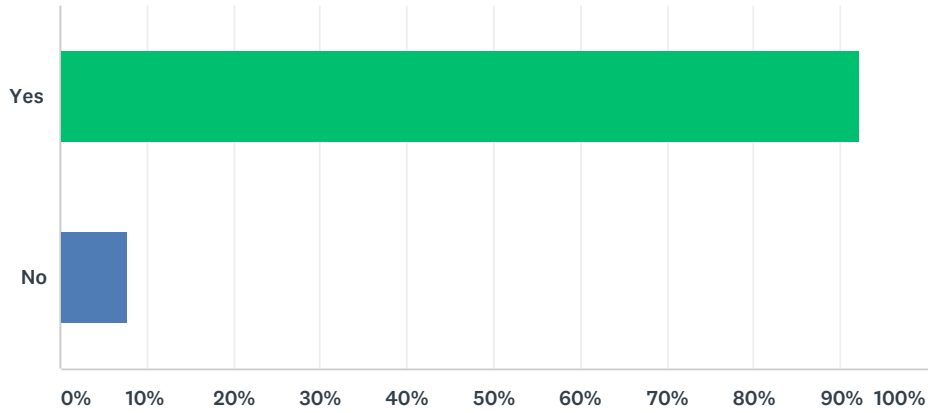

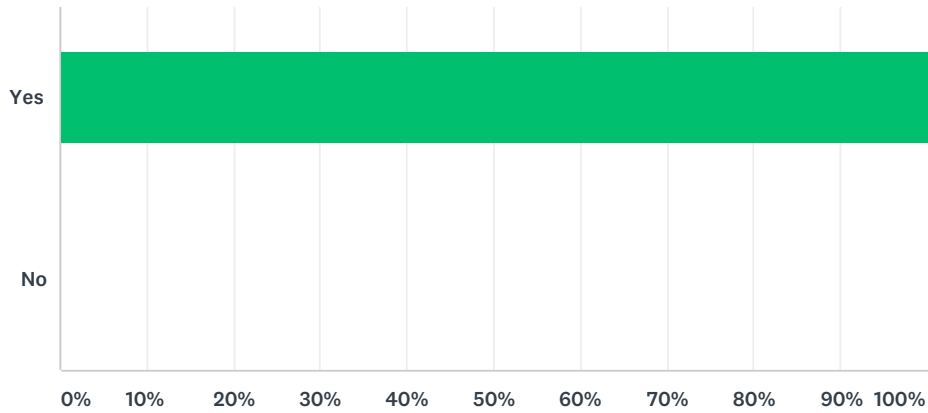

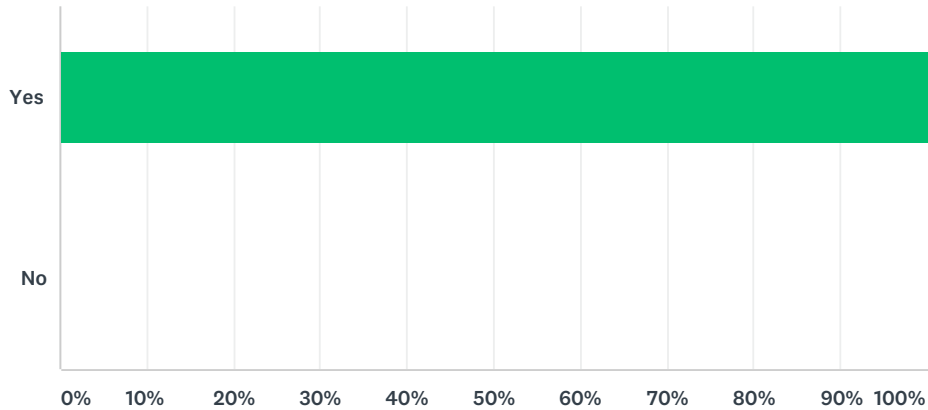

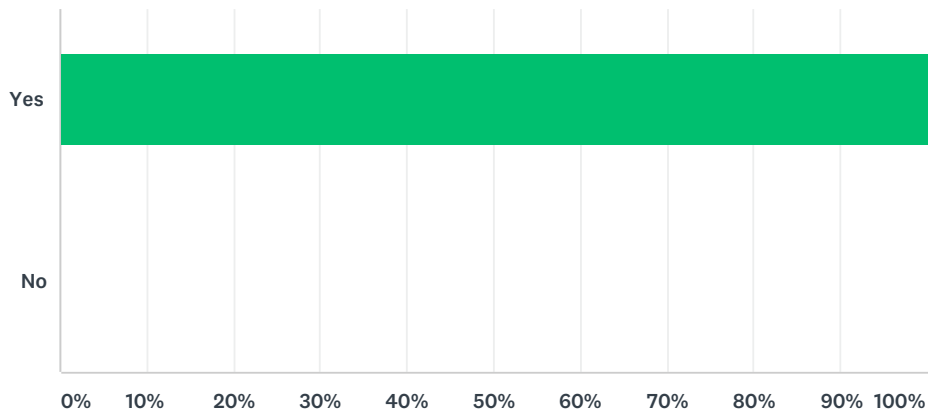

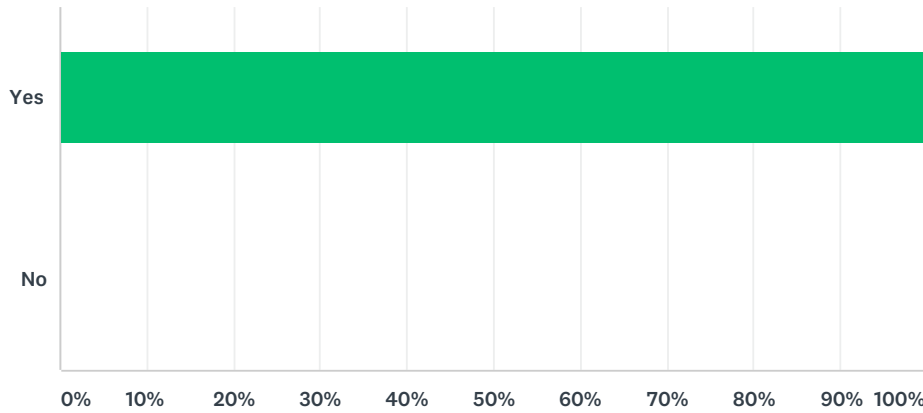

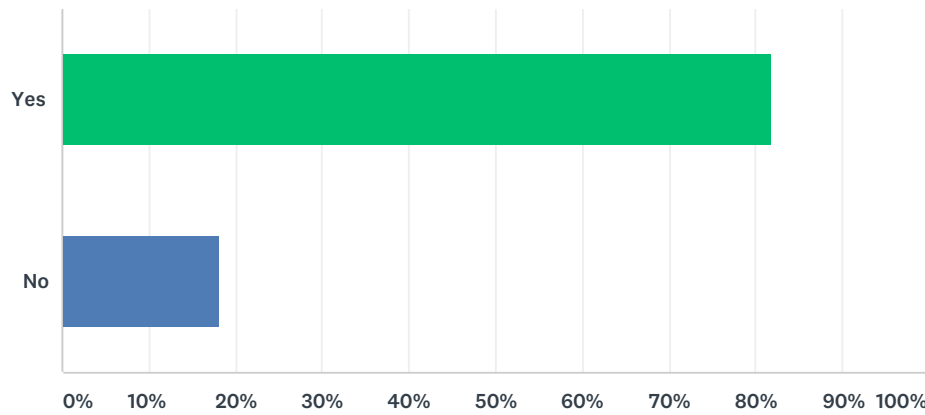

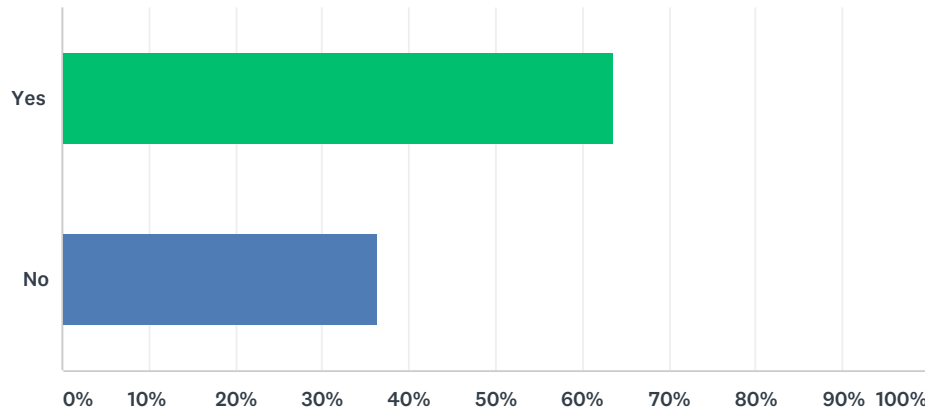

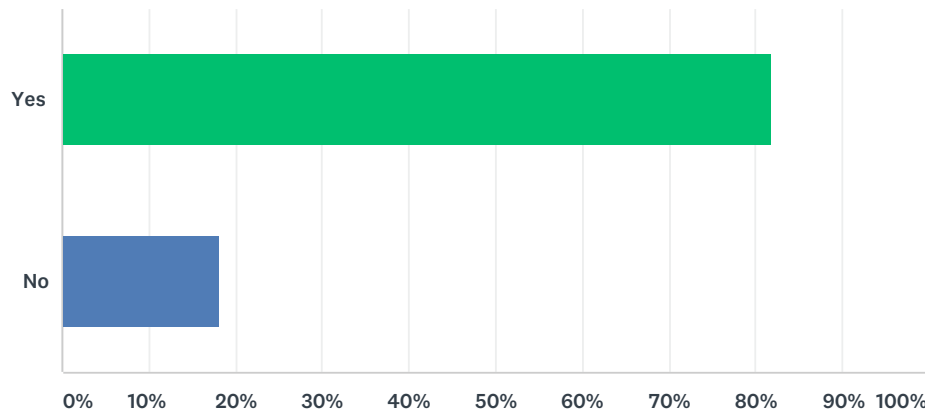

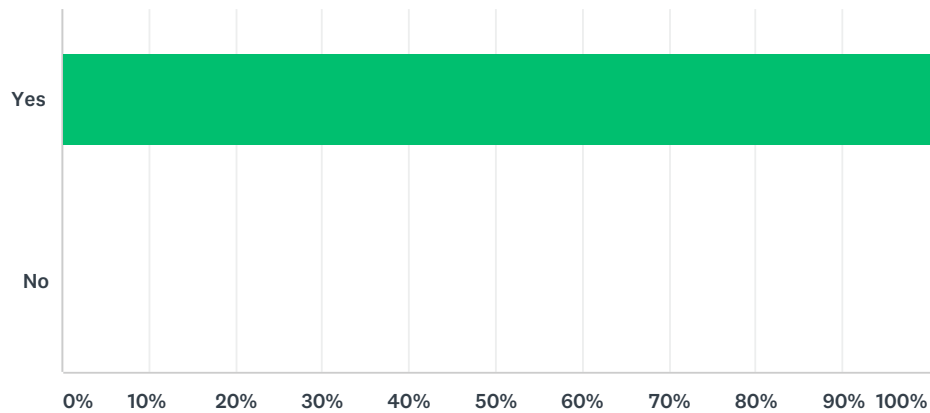

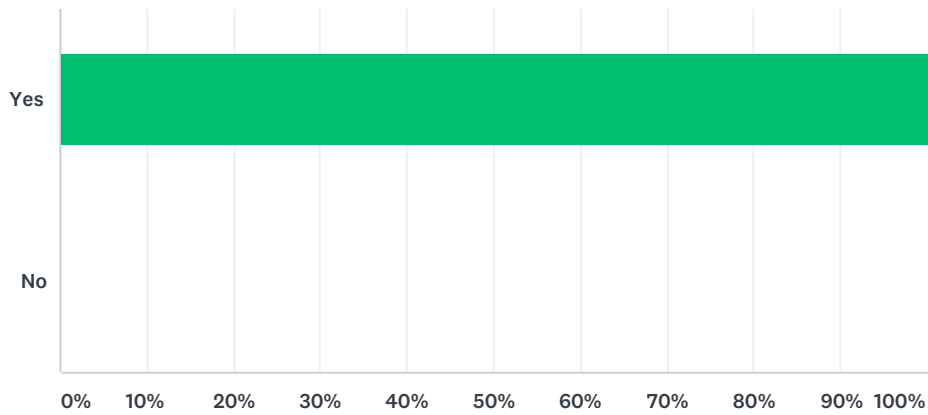

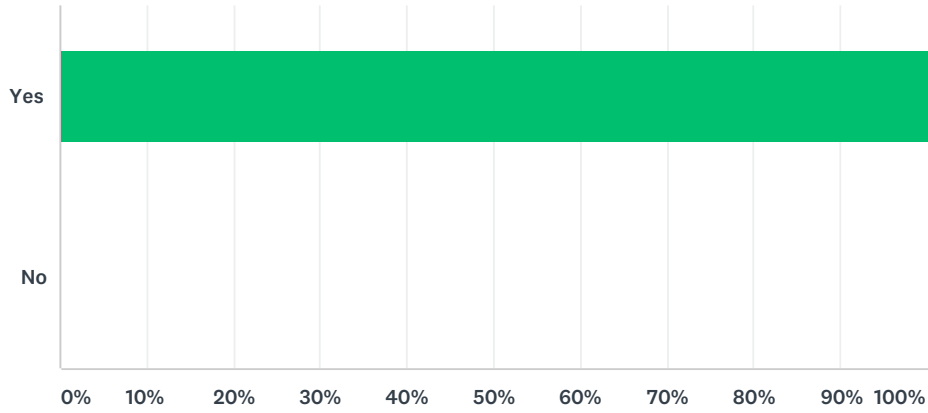

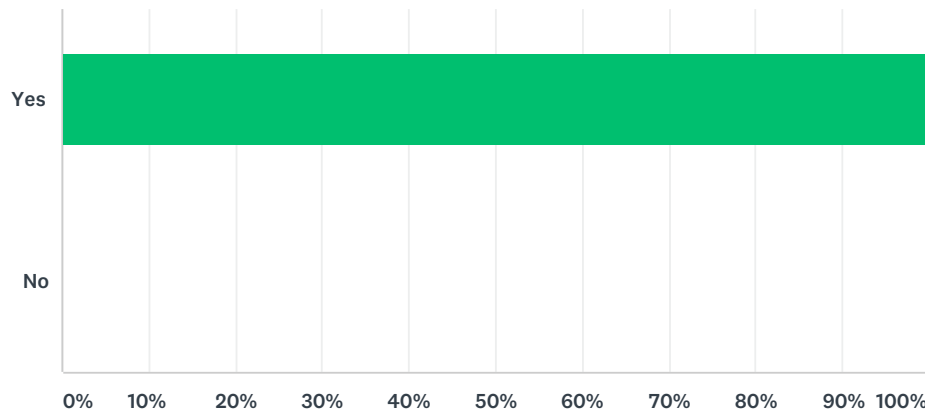

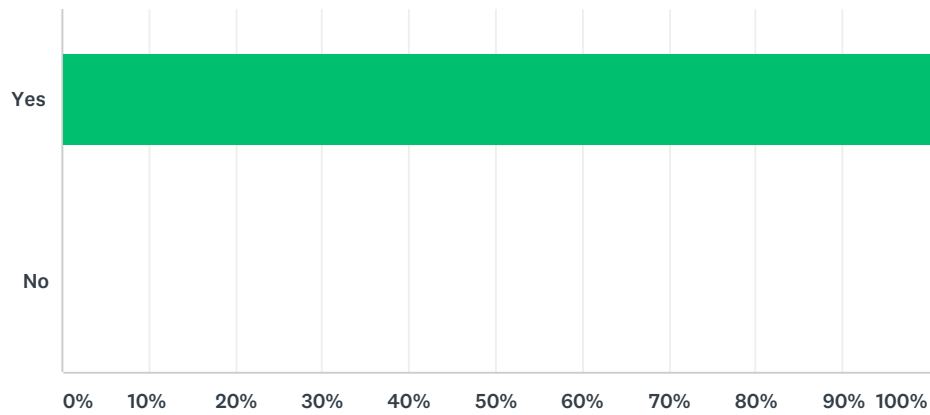

### Q29 We provide physical education for elementary students on a weekly basis.

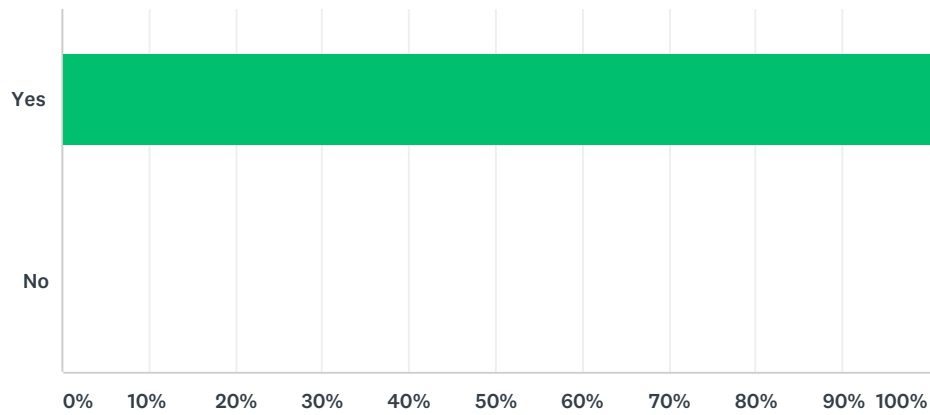

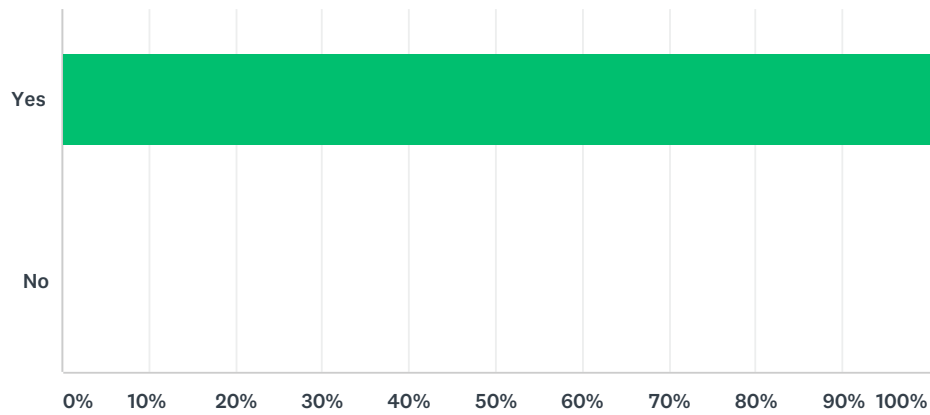

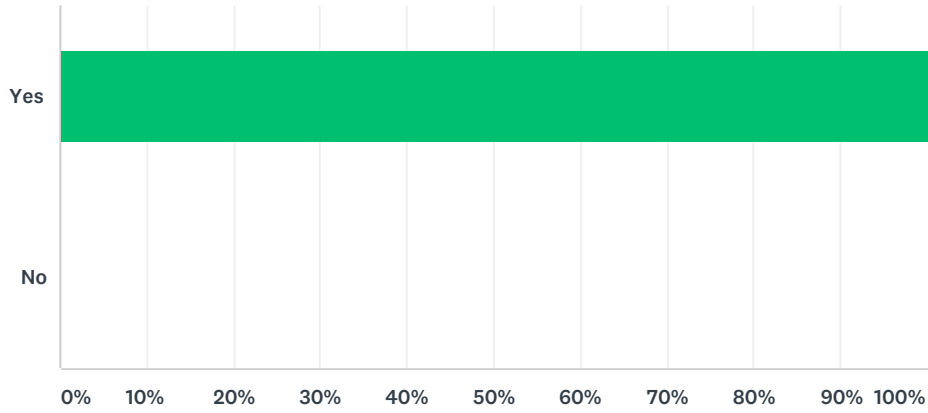

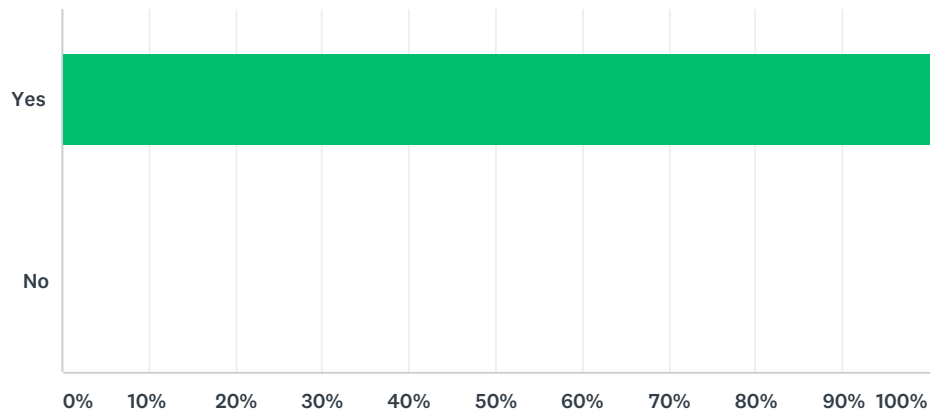

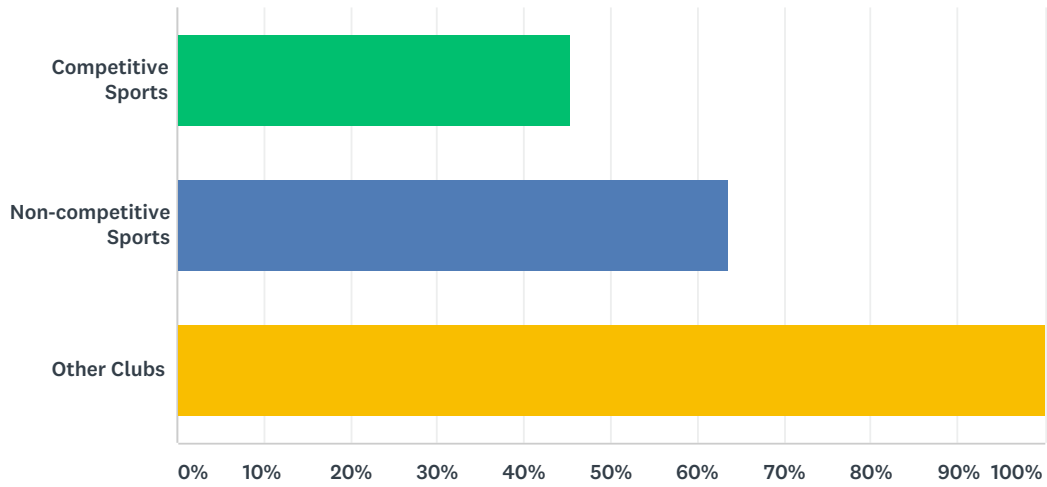

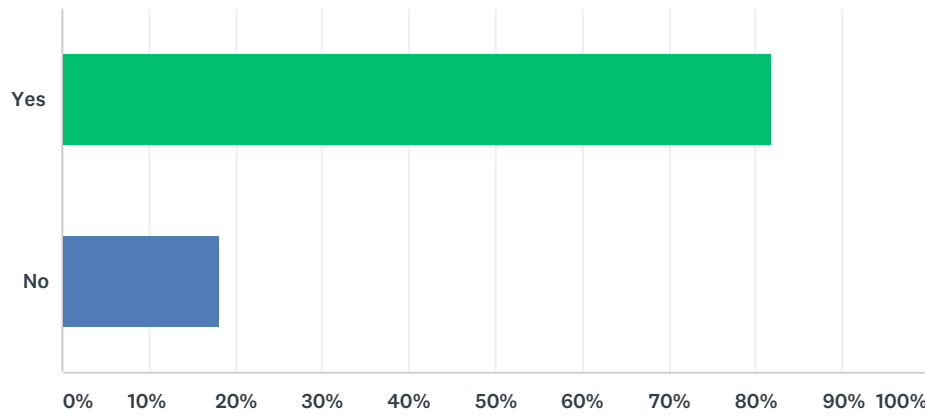

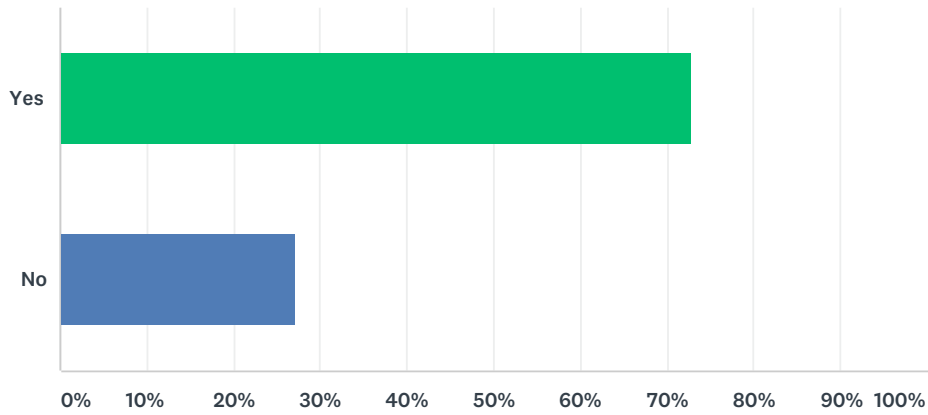

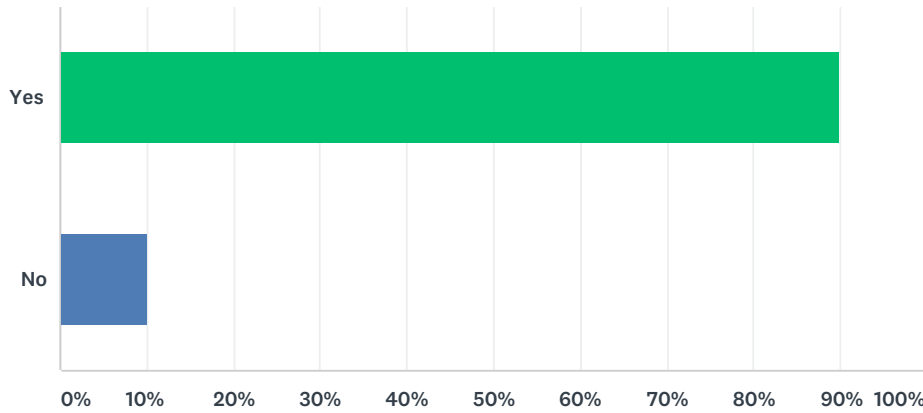

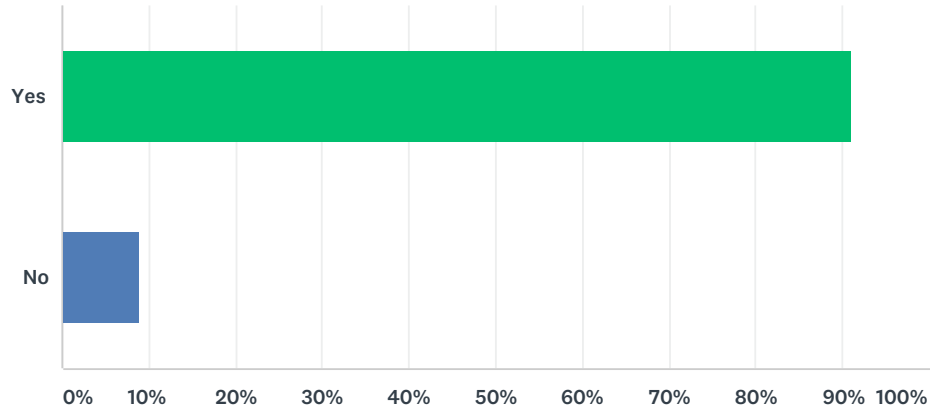

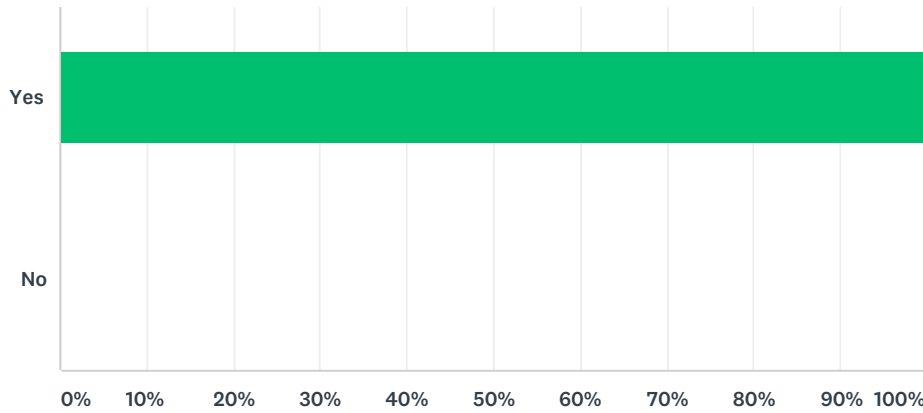

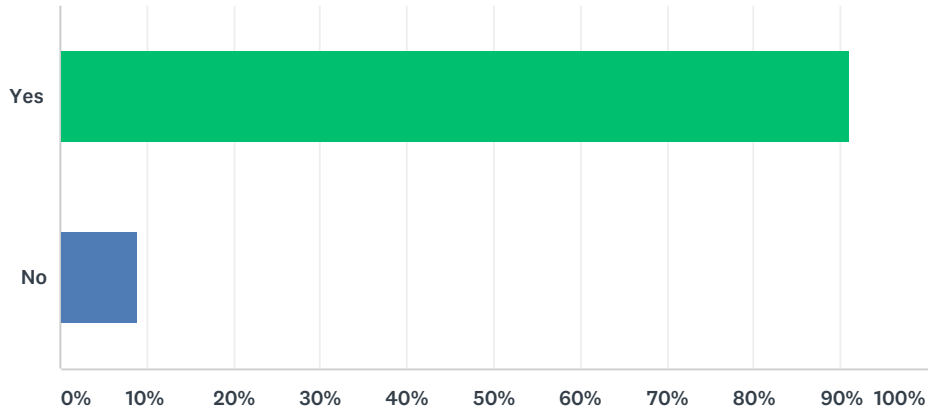

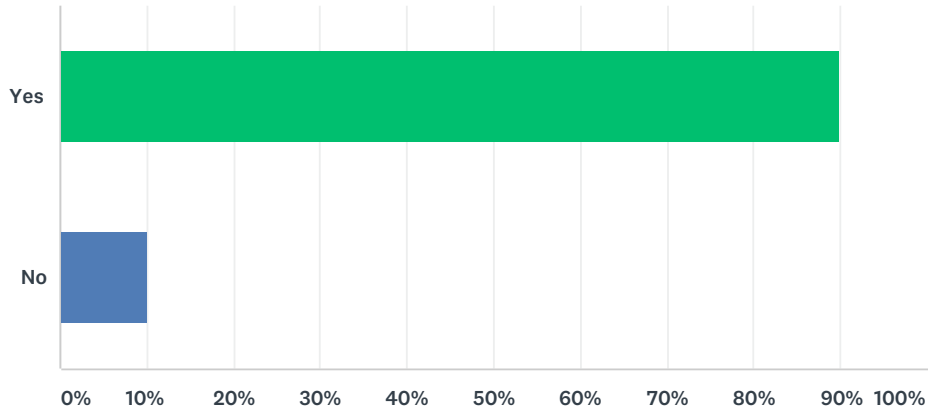
