

Career Exploration and Planning

2. Individuals → Get started → K-12 Student → Take the guided tour → Let's go
3. Create account. (Yes-allow teachers to view your backpack)
4. Once your account is created, you may/may not complete all the steps to update your profile. Either way, click on "Explore it" in the upper left corner of the menu bar.
5. Explore it → Career Profile
6. Take the Career Profile.
7. Once you get to the pie chart, notice your most dominant personality type and description(s).
8. Click on View Occupations (bottom left) and you will be directed to a list of occupations developed as a result of your Career Profile.
9. Explore careers by clicking on them. Careers with a "thumbs up" are in high demand. Once you click on a career you can learn more by viewing "Education and Training" on the bottom left to see colleges in Ohio offering that degree program. You can also click on "Career Pathway" to learn about recommended coursework for each career path.
