The Superintendent provided an update on teaching & learning, facilities, and operations.

Dr. Woodruff indicated there were 112 students signed up for summer school in grades one through nine. The State testing data was released for math, science and social studies. She will be doing a deep dive with teachers on three days over the summer. The high school was working on schedules for the upcoming school year. A special ed survey went out to all staff. There are many open positions due to retirements and internal transfers. Painting on the field house should begin soon.

Our website will be transitioning to another host over the summer. We are coming to the end of the Gaggle Pilot which is a student safety software. Interactive boards are being installed in some of the buildings to replace outdated boards. Fourth, seventh and eighth graders will be getting new devices for the upcoming school year. Grades one through three will be transitioning to touchscreen Chromebooks instead of iPads. The wireless will be updated at the elementary school and the high school. We are beginning to transition to electronic human resource records.

The District is trying to be open and proactive in expressing expectations of behavior. It is open to working together with families to ensure that behaviors are appropriate.

We are going to accept legal counsel's recommendation about a settlement with Energy Optimizers.

Staff Appreciation Week was the first week of May. Dr. Woodruff read some of the highlights of the Class of 2022. Graduation is scheduled for May 20, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.
