I. Call to Order/Review Agenda

Dortch also explains the difference between Complete Withdrawal and a No Show to the members. A No Show is a student who has not attended any classes, has not been absent, and has not submitted any assignments. Complete withdrawal is a student who has attended classes or submitted an assignment and decides they no longer want to attend school.

IV. Enrollment - Tonyalle Rush

Rush thanks everyone and their team for their hard work. We are up 8.7% in headcount. Congratulations! Now, we are looking forward to maintaining and retaining the students we have. We currently have 1,076 students who are in pre-register status, and the Enrollment Services team is working with these students to get them completed. 2nd mini-term on campus starts October 11th. The on-campus purge date will be October 5th. Online 2nd mini-term starts October 17th and the purge date will be October 12th. Registration for Winter & Spring classes will begin on October 31st.
