Girls Tennis - The girls currently sit in a tie for 4th place with Ventura High School. They have a huge match tomorrow against Ventura at Rio Mesa. The first time they played at Ventura it was tied 9-9 and came down to games won. Ventura edged us out. The girls have had a great year especially since the addition of the three Santa Barbara schools has made the league one of the toughest leagues in the CIF Southern Section.

Boys and Girls Cross Country - Both teams have had some outstanding individual performances one was by Nicholas Weinerth who has ran the second fastest three-mile cross country time in the history of the school. Nicholas also won his race at the prestigious Woodbridge Invitational in Irvine with a time of 14 minutes and 50 Seconds.

Also, at this meet Anna Dahlquist won her heat. Coach Emily Hall compares her to one of the best runners in recent memory at Rio Mesa Sophia Godina. Anna is showing a ton of potential and is only a Sophomore.

Boys' Water Polo: The boys currently have an overall record of right around 500. They have a big game this Wednesday vs. Buena at Rio Mesa 3:15.
