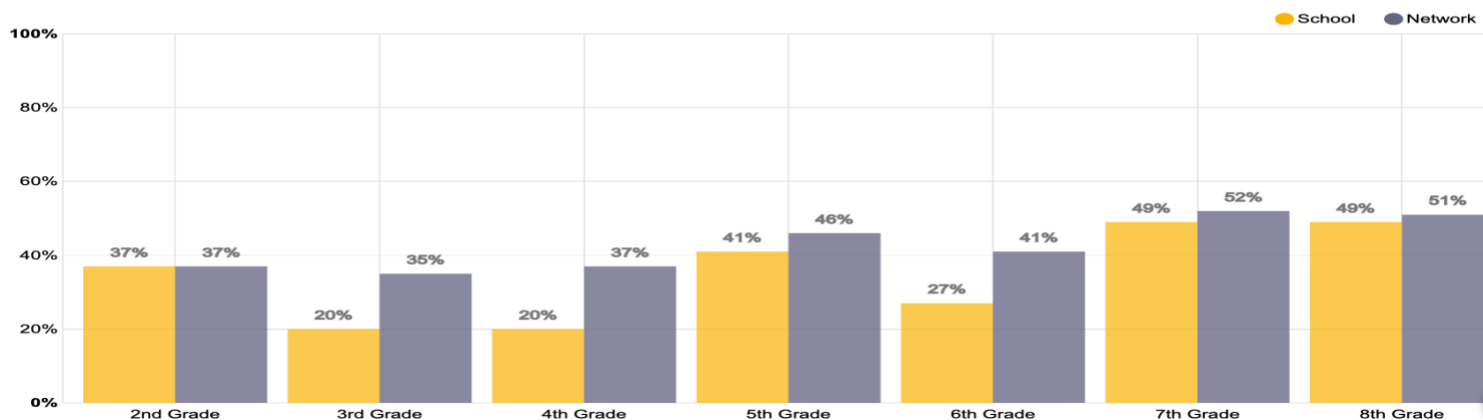

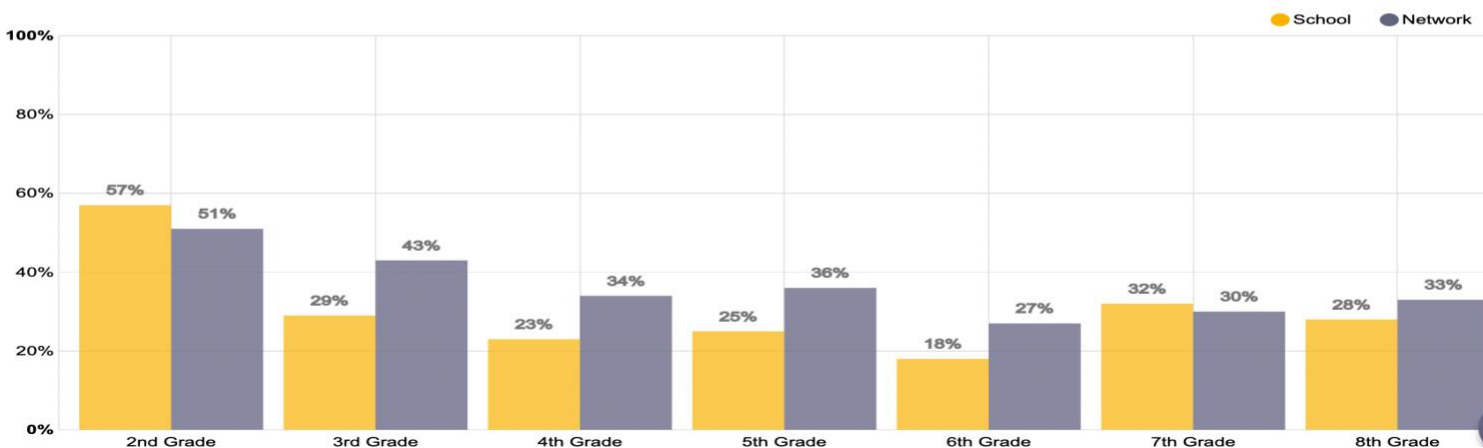
2022 ELA CrossNetwork Online ELA 22-23 All Courses All Cycles **Update** CSV

### Read by Grade 3 Law

In 2016, the Michigan Legislature passed a law that requires schools to identify learners who are struggling with reading and writing and to provide additional help. The law states that third graders may repeat third grade if they are more than one grade level behind beginning with the 2019-2020 school year. More information to come. ### Exact Path

Exact path is our Title I funded intervention that is based on student NWEA scores. Students are completing during the school day, however extra practice is indicated to reduce the Covid loss that has occurred. Students should be using it daily at least 80-100 minutes per week!
