2021-2022 Goals

MATH - Increase 2% CRT and Rise, CRT replaced with Acadience Math
-K-3 average prof. 68.1%

ELA - Writing: 75% 3-6 show proficiency Rise benchmark

-No data, canceled benchmark requirement

Reading: K-3 show 77% typical/higher progress 2022 EOY Acadience

-64% typical/higher

Reading: 4-6 87% composite score at or above benchmark

-80.3% at or above

Reading: 3-6 average 68% proficiency ELA RISE

58% proficiency (10% lower school was testing to stay at the time)

STEM - K-6 academically benefit from InfiniD lab participation

-Science scores increased 1%

PROFESSIONAL DEV. - Provide professional learning opportunities for teachers

-LETRS/Apple Certifications.

SEL - achievement increase with PBIS implementation (recognition of good behavior)
-Increased 4%

Math - 75% of 1-6 show typical/growth -BOY to EOY in IREADY

-Purchase IReady K-5, Go Math for 6

-Use IReady diagnostics

-Monthly Data meetings, half day instruction for Tier 1/2

ELA - Writing: 75% 3-6 show proficiency RISE benchmark

Reading: 70% K-3 show typical/higher on EOY Acadience

Reading: 85% 4-6 composite score at/above EOY Acadience benchmark

-Literacy Coach work on science of reading/implementing at Tier 1

-Monthly progress monitoring/assessments Tier 1/2

-Aides assist Tier 2

-Provide collaboration times

-Student rubric guide on writing prompts

STEM - (TSSA Funded) All students experience InfiniDlab 4 times/year

SEL- Achievement will increase through teaching/implementation PBIS system, positive response of survey 3-6 will increase
