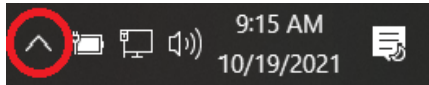
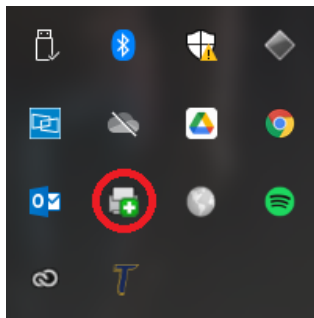


How to add a Network Printer

1. On the right corner click on the arrow.



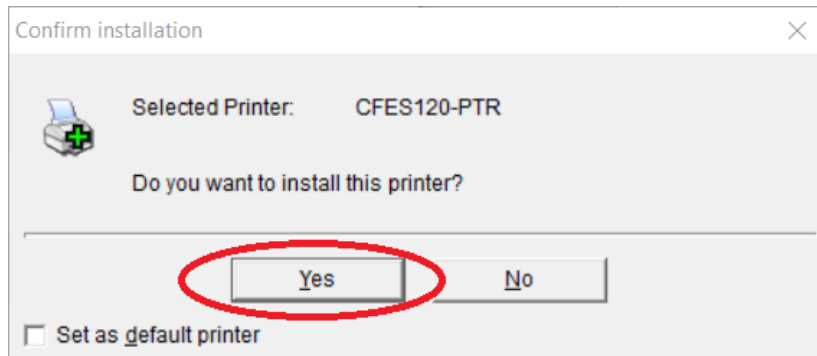
2. Click on the icon of the printer with a green plus sign.



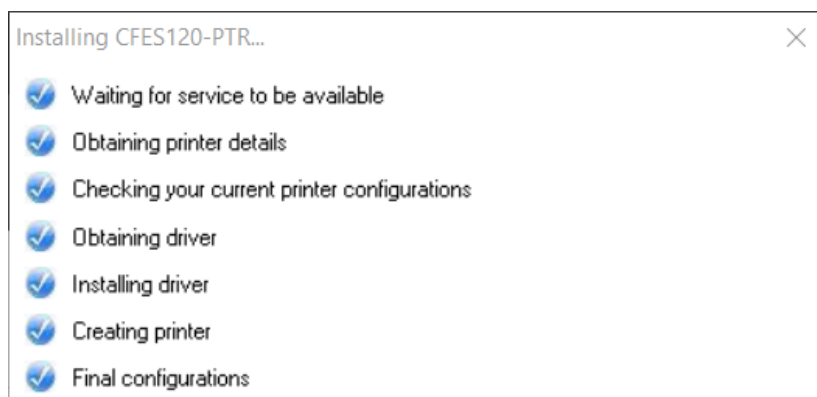
3. This will bring up a webpage with a list of printers to install. (Click on the folder if no printers are displayed)
