

MANKATO EAST HIGH SCHOOL WALL OF DISTINCTION

Throughout the history of Mankato East High School, numerous individuals have made a significant and lasting impact on advancing the recognition of Mankato's educational community. Individuals-- who have made a difference, who have been successful, who have given unselfishly to make the world a better place-- deserve to be nominated for induction into the Mankato East High School Wall of Distinction.

PURPOSE:

- to recognize the achievements of Mankato East High School graduates
- to demonstrate incentives and provide role models for East students

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Graduated from Mankato East High School a minimum of 15 years prior to the nomination
2. Exemplified ethical behavior, moral character, and leadership during and/or following her/his high school career that is a credit to MEHS or the community
3. Distinguished themselves in one or more of the following areas after high school---
 - accomplishments in the arts and/or academic fields
 - humanitarian endeavors
 - professional career accomplishments and achievements
 - community service
 - athletic accomplishments on the college or professional levels
 - distinguished military service
 - exceptional contributions to School District #77
4. Wall of Distinction recognition may be given posthumously

PROCEDURES:

1. The induction ceremony takes place every even-numbered year on Homecoming Day.
2. Nominations may be submitted by East alumni, family members, current or retired faculty /District 77 employees, or friends of an East graduate.
3. Nominations must be submitted on an official nomination form available at Mankato East High School or on the MEHS website (mankatoeasthighschool/wallof distinction).
4. Corroborating data (news articles, notices, photos, etc.) may be submitted with the form.
5. No more than two letters of recommendation may be included supporting why this individual is worthy of the honor. (please limit each letter to ONE typewritten page).
6. Nominations for the next class of inductees (2024) must be submitted no later than **October 15, 2023.**

Should the nominated candidate not be selected in the first year of consideration, the nomination will automatically be kept on file and will be considered by the selection committee for future inductions. Additional documentation and information may be submitted for future consideration.
