Reading is a Non-Negotiable for DEPSA students: Did you know....

NAEP (National Association of Educational Procurement) results show that students who read more frequently have higher scores—and **the score gap between frequent readers and infrequent readers gets bigger as students get older**. Among nine-year-olds, there was only an 18-point difference between children who reported reading "never or hardly ever" and those who read "almost every day." By age 13, the gap widened to 27 points. At age 17, it further increased to 30 points!

Some researchers estimate that children learn 1 new word for every 1,000 words read. Between kindergarten and twelfth grade, students with an average daily reading time of 30 or more minutes are projected to encounter 13.7 million words—so they should learn around 13,700 new vocabulary words from independent reading practice alone. In contrast, students who read less than 15 minutes per day would learn only 1,500 new vocabulary words from reading. That's a vocabulary gap of 12,200 words!
