- Data dashboard update

Chronic absentee rate given 41.08%, 861 are chronically absent. Chronic would be missing 10% or more school days. Next month will have a record of what year in school they are. There is a team at CHS to help communicate with kids and parents to know why they are missing. This report is pulled weekly. Once they have hit 4-5 days the system will trigger and the team will start to investigate what is going on.

Refining the data on disciplinary items so that it is more accurate. I.e. truancy may not be included in this category. It isn't something that is making the kids not feel safe. Numbers are improving in part because expectations are more clear from admin and teachers.

Talking about teacher retention, a survey was discussed as they exit. Not as a district but as CHS. What could we do to get you to stay, how could we improve, how was your environment at your school? There was a marked difference in last year to this year to boost morale and climate for the teachers.

ESSER money has to be spent this year, this will be used to help with the money lost by a grant used for the seniors now.

- School Goal Update

Pass rate was just above 90% for the first term up from 87% last year

Go look at the school calendar and give feedback.

The Bond passed, so for CHS they are moving forward with the New CTE/fine arts building. Construction will start in the summer of '24 and will be about 1.5-2 yr. project. Preliminary models should be out by the spring/summer of this year
