## ACADEMIC COMMITTEE ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

### 1. Contract for Professional Services IU13

Dr. Godfrey presented a contract for Professional Services with IU13 Lancaster Lebanon Virtual Solutions (LLVS). LLVS is the District's provider for online learning. There were no major changes to the contract and the District will continue to provide equipment and technical support to our students who are enrolled as full-time in the program. Dr. Godfrey provided the Committee with an update on the current number of students in the program K-12. He answered questions from the Committee. The Committee was supportive of recommending the contract for approval at the May 2, 2022, meeting of the full Board of Directors.

### 2. Dual/Concurrent Enrollment Update

Dr. Godfrey shared an overview of the current agreements the District has with local universities and colleges for dual/concurrent enrollment, including one articulation agreement and one early enrollment agreement. Current student dual enrollment numbers were reviewed as well. Dr. Godfrey also presented four agreements for renewal including:

- Delaware Valley College – Articulation Agreement
- Thaddeus Stevens – Dual/Concurrent Enrollment Agreement
- Penn State York – Dual/Concurrent Enrollment Agreement
- PA College of Health Sciences – Dual/Concurrent Enrollment Agreement

The Committee was supportive of recommending the contracts for approval at the May 2, 2022, meeting of the full Board of Directors. Copies of each agreement were sent to Committee members following the meeting for review. Questions will be directed to Dr. Godfrey.
