Academic Committee Meeting Minutes

Mr. Parido called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

ACADEMIC COMMITTEE ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

1. Contract for Professional Development Services IU13

Dr. Godfrey presented a contract for Professional Development Services with IU13 to support L-S staff through coaching and face-to-face professional learning sessions for the implementation of Hybrid and Personalized Learning in all buildings. Professional Development services aligned with District Comprehensive Planning goals may also be provided. The contract is for up to 55 days of service. The Committee was supportive of recommending the contract to the full Board of Directors at the March 7, 2022, meeting for approval.

2. Textbook Approval: The Practice of Statistics, Sixth Edition (Advanced Placement Statistics).

Dr. Godfrey presented a new textbook, The Practice of Statistics, Sixth Edition (Advanced Placement Statistics), to the Committee for approval. He shared the book was reviewed and recommended by the high school mathematics department, the high school principal, and the District's Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment Mathematics Committee. The Committee was supportive of recommending the textbook to the full Board of Directors at the March 7, 2022, meeting for approval.

3. After-School Programming Update

Dr. Godfrey provided the Committee with an update on the proposed after-school programming for Spring, 2022. He stated that 32 teachers would be recommended for approval to provide services to students in grades one through eight. Program invitation letters will be sent out on Monday, February 14, 2022. Dr. Godfrey also shared that late bus transportation will be provided at parent request.

4. Curriculum Overview Series: It All Starts with Standards

Dr. Godfrey presented an overview of State Standards including the history of standards requirements, how they are mandated in the school code, and what standards documents look like. At the March meeting, Dr. Godfrey will review How Standards Become Curriculum. A copy of the presentation is attached to these minutes.
