STRASBURG ELEMENTARY BASKETBALL COURT

Mr. John Johnson, a Strasburg Borough resident, addressed the Committee regarding concerns of constant commotion from the basketball court at Strasburg Elementary. This was a follow-up to his letter submitted for public comment at the regular Board meeting on August 3, 2020, and public comment at the regular Board meeting on August 2, 2021. The Committee reviewed the situation with Mr. Johnson and asked the Administration to:

- continue to monitor and keep the Committee apprised as necessary
- review signage at Strasburg Elementary with Strasburg Police to ensure it is enforceable
- respond to Borough of Strasburg letter

FEASIBILITY STUDY IMPLEMENTATION UPDATE

Mr. Stoltzfus updated the Committee on the implementation of the Feasibility Study. On Thursday, August 19, 2021, the team will be meeting with West Lampeter Township Planning Commission regarding the design of the potential Early Childhood Center building. As previously discussed, enrollments will be a huge factor for this potential project and updates are expected for the next Committee meeting on September 20, 2021.

The Critical Capital Projects continue on schedule for bidding first round of projects in September, 2021, and second round in January, 2022. Of concern right now are equipment lead times and material cost spikes.

HIGH SCHOOL REQUEST FOR FUME HOOD SYSTEM FOR LASER CUTTER

Mr. Stoltzfus requested permission to purchase a Fume Hood System at a cost of approximately \$15,000 for the Lampeter-Strasburg High School. The system was reviewed by Dr. Feeney, Mr. Garber and Mr. Davis, and recommended as the best option to exhaust the Laser Cutter. The Committee discussed and asked that the Administration review an "inline fan" option, but fully support moving forward with Mr. Davis' final recommendation either way.

Mr. Stoltzfus shared from Mr. Davis that his staff and summer crews did a great job getting ready for the upcoming school year and all buildings are looking forward to a great start to the year.
