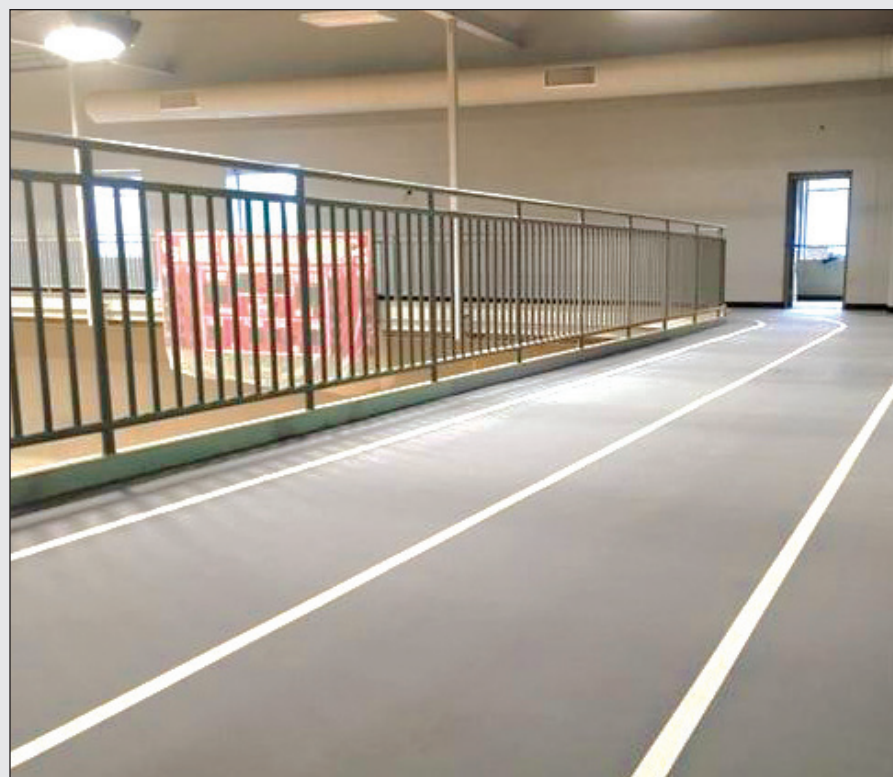

The walking track at CSHS is open to the public. The track is open from 8:30-11 am on school days. Walkers must enter door #4 and bring a valid driver's license or state ID.

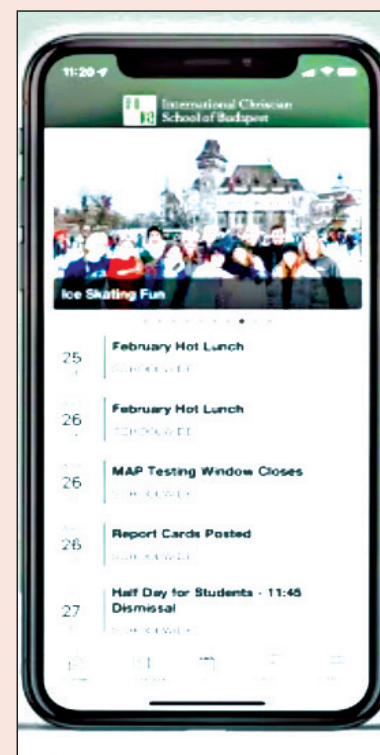


Download the Official Canton Local App

Good Beginnings Never End

In September, FMES hosted Good Beginnings Never End! a fun-filled evening of books, literacy activities, and families spending time together. Each year the elementary school has a week-long literacy event where they highlight different book genres, authors, and titles in hopes of sparking excitement for literacy in our students. This year, students had to identify a "mystery reader" each morning. Students in the winning class received books. The PTO hosted the Scholastic Book Fair and made it a priority that every student leaves with at least one book in hand. The culminating event is the literacy night that encourages students and families to interact with literature. Families played games, took home books, enjoyed refreshments, and even took in a sneak peak of CSHS theater production, *Once Upon A Mattress*. We thank all of our families for making literacy an important part of their homes!

Partners Promote Literacy

In partnership with National Network of Partnership Schools (NNPS) FMES has developed a community-school partnership called Literacy Partners. This partnership is aimed at strengthening the love for literacy amongst students by having community members engage in literacy activities with them throughout the week. Currently there are about a dozen community partners working with our first grade students either 1-1 or in small groups. Each of the volunteers have been specifically trained in different literacy practices and have detailed plans on how to engage students. The group aims to decrease the number of students who are not engaged in literacy and help put each child on a road to literacy success!

Please join us this holiday season for a memorable show highlighting the musical talents of our kindergarten and first grade students. Kindergarten students will be performing at 6:00 pm and first graders at 7:00 pm. The programs are under the direction of music teacher, **Ms. Feller**.

Leadership Groups Formed

Through our PBIS program, a variety of third-fifth grade student leadership groups have been developed that focus on providing students with knowledge and experiences to help them grow as individuals within our community. We have over 75 third graders participating in the Wildcat Fitness Ninjas, which stresses the importance of healthy eating, exercise, and friendships. There are over 50 fourth graders participating in the Pride Patrol, which focuses on exposing students to different career paths. Currently over 35 fifth graders are participating in the Pride Pack, which focuses on mentorship with our students at CSMS and CSHS. Our fifth graders also have opportunities to participate in our school video announcements and our quarterly school newspaper. 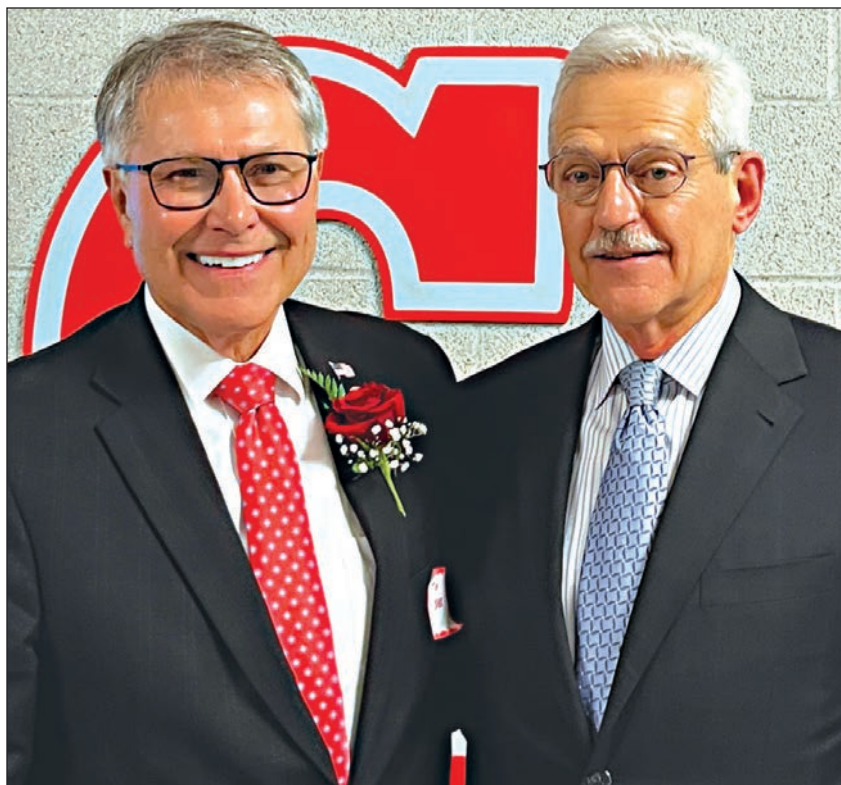

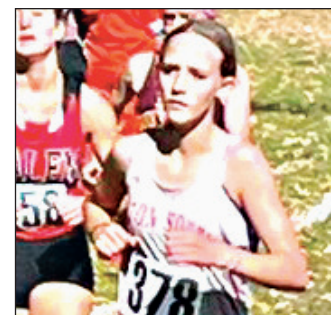

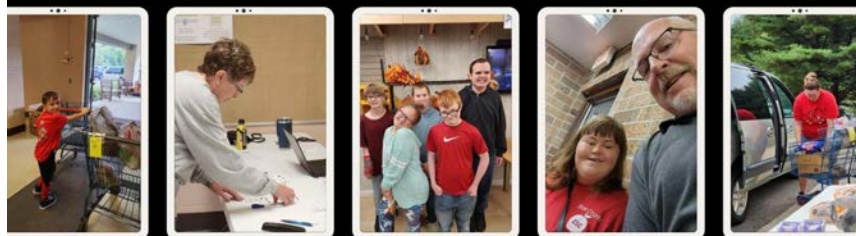
