Credit by Exam With Prior Instruction

The Tomball Independent School District offers students this opportunity to gain credit for courses or grade levels through successful completion of appropriate examinations.

Eligibility

- Students enrolled in TISD in grades 6-12 who have previous formal instruction in the courses requested. The student must have received a grade of at least 60 in the course failed in order to gain credit by examination.
- On approval of the attendance committee, a student who has excessive absences may be permitted to earn or regain course credit.
- Credit by Examination shall not be used to gain eligibility for participation in extracurricular activities.

Criteria for Credit

Grade 6

- A minimum score of 70% on each of the core subjects (reading/language arts, mathematics, social studies and science)
- Written approval for credit by parent/guardian
- School district representative recommends approval

Criteria for Credit (continued)

Grades 7-8

- A minimum score of 70% on each semester test for course credit
- A minimum score of 70% on each of the core subjects (reading/language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies) for credit by grade level
- Written approval for credit by parent/guardian
- School district representative recommends approval

High School Courses*

- A minimum score of 70% on each exam (one per semester) in a subject area to be awarded ½ unit of credit.
- Written approval for credit by parent/guardian
- School district representative recommends approval

*** Students must score a minimum of 70 percent to be awarded credit. Any score for which credit is awarded will be recorded on the academic achievement record. Scores below 70% will not be posted on the student's academic achievement record.**
