Reading:

We are working on a unit called, Ways Characters Shape Stories. In this unit, students will read a range of famous poems, folktales, and myths with well-known characters. They will synthesize information to be able to explain how our actions influence our lives.

Writing:

We are currently working on our informational texts. Students have been working on their body paragraphs, and making sure to include just the facts. Our next unit will be opinion writing. Students will write opinion pieces on a topic where they introduce it, state an opinion, and write body paragraphs that include supporting details.

Math:

We have begun a unit on operations. Students are using place value to develop and practice strategies for addition and subtraction. They represent multiplication using arrays, and use these representations to develop strategies for solving multiplication facts.
