Laser Run Leaderboard

This term the children have been honing their skills in Laser Run, part of the Pentathlon work in sports sessions. The Leaderboard is constantly changing, a reflection of the improvement the children are seeing in their performance.

Laser Run involves using digital guns to shoot at targets. The aim is to shoot five within 50 seconds. Children who do so may run the 200 metre course and return for a second time. If five targets are not completed then children must wait the full 50 seconds before running.
