- Sean G. attended PACE meeting with the levy renewal presentation. Need to get public aware this is a RENEWAL. Not a new tax. Plan on doing some sign waving in January or February.
- Need to bill \$70 to the school for Bookfair.
- Vicki Rockholt brought concerns from student council about the possibility of getting playground equipment more geared toward the older students and a track. The PE grant did not go through at the beginning of the year to fund the track. The student council would also like to see a carnival or big field day at end of year. PTO would like to see council put together an idea and proposal.
