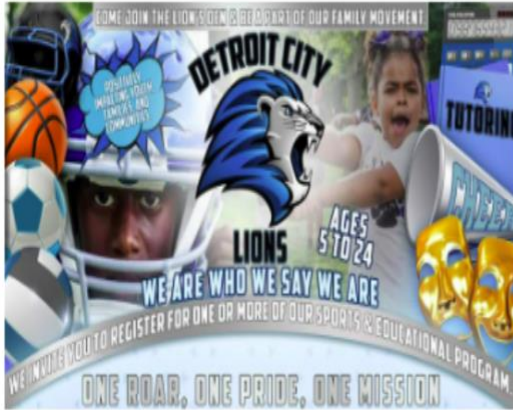

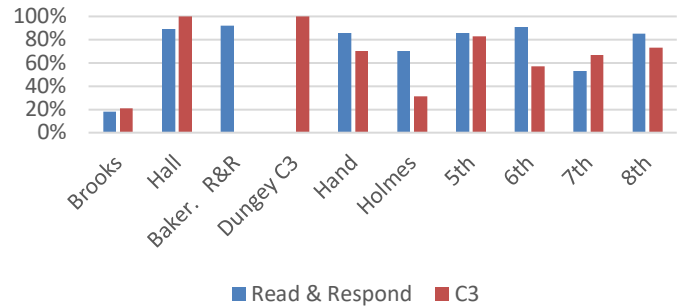

In 2016, the Michigan Legislature passed a law that requires schools to identify learners who are struggling with reading and writing and to provide additional help. The law states that third graders may repeat third grade if they are. More than one grade level behind beginning with the 2019-2020 school year. More information to come. **MIDDLE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE TIPS
DID YOU KNOW? WHAT YOU CAN DO**

- Students should miss no more than 9 days of school each year to stay engaged, successful and on track to graduation.
- Frequent absences can be a sign that a student is losing interest in school, struggling with school work, dealing with a bully or facing some other difficulty.
- By 6th grade, absenteeism is one of three signs that a student may drop out of high school.
- By 9th grade, attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores. • Missing 10%, or 2 days a month, over the course of the school year, can affect a student's academic success.

Exact Path

Exact path is our Title I funded intervention that is based on student NWEA scores. Students are completing during the school day, however extra practice is indicated to reduce the Covid loss that has occurred. Students should be using it daily at least 80-100 minutes per week!
