

Pennsylvania Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC)

Redirect your personal or business taxes to Villa Joseph Marie to help build our available financial aid for qualifying students.

The Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) program allows Pennsylvania tax liabilities to be diverted to financial aid programs for students at Villa Joseph Marie, rather than to the Commonwealth, helping ensure that our socio-economic profile remains broad and diverse and that all qualified young women, regardless of financial means, have access to a Villa education.

EITC By the Numbers...

Thirty-seven Donors in 2021...

Join the thirty-seven business and individual taxpayers who utilized the EITC program to make a commitment to Catholic education by diverting their PA tax liability to support financial aid at Villa.

Nearly 40 students empowered...

With the assistance of donors making a commitment through EITC in the 2021-2022 school year, nearly 40 qualified students attended Villa who, otherwise, would have been unable to attend.

Seven Easy Steps...

1. Estimate your 2022 PA tax liability—See a recent pay stub, line 12 of your 2021 PA personal return, or line 13 of your business return as a starting point
2. Select a one- (75% credit) or two- (90% credit) year commitment
3. Contact Villa Advancement
4. Receive and sign the participation documents through DocuSign (be sure to designate Villa as the recipient of your donation!)
5. Within 60 days of signing, make your payment (payment must be made by December 31 to qualify for 2022)
6. In March 2023, receive the documents necessary to take the credit on your tax return
7. Know that your generosity has made a difference for a student who, otherwise, would have been unable to afford a high-quality, Catholic education at Villa Joseph Marie!
