



Child Nutrition Unveils New *Afterschool Meals Program* at No Cost to Students



Tomball ISD continues to strive to go above and beyond for the well-being of every student it serves district-wide. Whether it's an afterschool activity or an enrichment program, Tomball ISD has placed an emphasis on serving students at the highest levels across all departments.

The Child Nutrition Department, led by Director Whitney Johnson, has shifted its focus from school meals to the 'providing nutritionally sound meal choices, attractively served in a pleasant environment by professionally trained staff members.'

From innovative meal choices to a nutritionally-based plan, the Child Nutrition Department added to its repertoire and unveiled a new Afterschool Meals Program to Tomball ISD students at the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year.

The Afterschool Meals Program provides students who participate in afterschool and extracurricular activities with healthy meals free of charge to the student.

"We noticed a desire for this program as many of our students participated in athletics, fine arts or academic extracurricular activities. This program is a benefit to Tomball ISD because it provides our students an extra source of nutrition that will hold them over before they return home from their extended school day," Johnson said.

In order to provide this service, organizations have to meet the following criteria:

- be organized primarily to provide care for children after school
- provide organized, regularly scheduled activities
- include educational or enrichment activities open to all students
- be located in an eligible area

Tomball High School met the necessary criteria to host the new program. This program is funded through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and they work with State agencies to administer the program and communicate with both USDA and Tomball ISD.

Currently, breakfast and lunch meals are offered through a reimbursement program but students must qualify to either be placed in either the free or reduced category. The Afterschool Meals Program is also an entitlement program similar to breakfast and lunch but every meal offered in this new program is considered a part of the free reimbursement category.

The money Tomball ISD receives through the reimbursement program is put directly back into the cost of meals and labor to provide the best nutrition and quality for all students.

Due to the high volume of students remaining on campus after school hours for extracurricular activities or tutoring made Tomball High School an ideal location for the hosting site of this new program. This program is not only available to just Tomball High School students, but open to all Tomball ISD students at no cost. At this time, students must find their own transportation to THS for the afterschool program.




The program currently serves free afterschool meals from 2:45 p.m. to 3:45 p.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays in the cafeteria at Tomball High School.

The Afterschool Meals Program has proven its success thus far, serving over 200 meals a day during the first two weeks of school.

"We will continue to monitor the Afterschool Meals Program and the logistics we have put in place to begin the program and make changes if we feel like they are needed. We are very pleased with the response thus far and are happy to provide our students this service after a long day in the classroom," Johnson said.



DR. MIKE METZ | THS, '98 **Tomball Memorial High School Principal**

Coming home was never a question for him.

"I wanted to be able to feel that connection of pouring back into something, and a place, that invested so much in me and really shaped me as a young man."

As the new principal of Tomball Memorial High School, Dr. Mike Metz will have the opportunity to continue to pour into the district he calls home.

His parents bought a house in Tomball in 1979. After graduating from Tomball High School (Class of '98), he attended Texas A&M University, where he received a Bachelor of Science Degree. Continuing his education, he earned a Master of Education Degree from Sam Houston State University, and later a Doctorate in Educational Leadership from Lamar University.



Returning to Tomball in 2004, Dr. Metz started his professional career as the head soccer coach at Tomball High School, coaching the team he played on during high school. In 2009, he got the opportunity to be an assistant principal at Northpointe Intermediate, and in 2012, he became an assistant principal at Tomball High School. In 2014, he left the district to take the principal role at Magnolia Junior High, and later Magnolia High School.

While Tomball today may be bigger than the Tomball Dr. Metz grew up in, to him, it is still the small town community that he grew to love.

"It has the advantages of a bigger district, but it still has the personal touch of a small town that truly cares about its kids and its community, and cares about the future of our nation. And you can see that. You can see little glimpses of that all over," Metz said. "Which is exactly why we chose to live here and it is exactly why I came back."

Moving into his new role as principal of Tomball Memorial High School, Metz will have the opportunity to reconnect with the community he built as a teacher and assistant principal at Tomball High School, and as an assistant principal at Northpointe Intermediate School.

"All of those relationships that I had built was the most reinforcing thing about me coming back to Tomball."

The value of relationships, as well as of work ethic, were instilled in Dr. Metz throughout his childhood in Tomball.

"There was always a sense of pride and accomplishment in the actual work we were doing and in the product you were producing," said Metz. "It helped me to be creative and have a vision for a future brighter than it is today, but then also gave me the work ethic to make sure that vision came to life."

It is this work ethic and vision that have brought him back to Tomball, time and time again.

"I have an opportunity to get a front-row seat to work with a staff, to cast a vision, and to inspire kids to achieve beyond whatever they thought possible," Metz said.

"There's no greater job than that."





