



STEAM CONFERENCE WELCOMES STUDENTS

In Tomball ISD, a focus on hands-on learning was evident once again as the 2019 STEAM Conference welcomed in TISD students, between grades 3-8, to Tomball Junior High. The district event was a half-day conference designed to expose students to Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics through education and mentoring opportunities while also providing critical learning sessions for students interested in STEAM.



SOCIAL EMOTIONAL

R.I.S.E. Program Implemented in Tomball ISD

The Restore Instruct Support and Education (RISE) is a substance use disorder program implemented in Tomball ISD made possible by funding from the Tomball Regional Health Foundation. RISE supports both substance use disorder assessment and intervention support for students referred by parents, teachers or through the campus disciplinary process. The RISE program is our attempt to address the root cause of substance use disorder as alternative to use of the discipline process alone.

What is R.I.S.E.?

Substance Use Assessment and Intervention

Referral

ALL students in Tomball ISD are eligible for R.I.S.E. The Student Intervention Team (SIT) at every campus has the ability to access this program for students in need. Possible referral sources could include students found, "Under the influence" on campus, students with positive alcohol and drug test results within the district's drug testing program or any student suspected of having a substance use disorder. Referrals may be made by parents, teachers and administrators.

Assessment

Teen and Family Services (TAFS) in partnership with Tomball ISD will complete all assessments of students referred to R.I.S.E from the campus Student Intervention Team (SIT). TAFS is a local organization committed to providing your teen and entire family the tools, skills and knowledge to deal with substance abuse problems in a holistic way. Following an assessment administered by a licensed clinician with TAFS the student and parents will be informed of the assessment results and the possible need for intervention. All assessment results are confidential and consent must be obtained from the student's parent prior to an assessment.

Intervention

Based on the assessment results, the licensed clinician from TAFS will determine the extent to which an intervention should be implemented. In general, most intervention programs will last from five to seven weeks. Following successful completion of an intervention TAFS will work with the family to provide extended support beyond the intervention period to maintain sobriety.

Why was R.I.S.E. implemented?



LESLIE [GEBHARDT] JOHNSON | THS, '00 Owner & Operator of Tomball Yard Greetings

“But the thing to realize is that your hometown will always be the first community you know and it watched you grow into the person you are today. If you have a chance to go back and change it or impact it no matter how great or small, you take that chance.”

Leslie Johnson, formally Leslie Gebhardt, returned to Tomball with her family in mind and is now successfully reconnecting with her community through her business, Tomball Yard Greetings, as the owner and operator since 2015.

“I started my business as a way to reconnect to our community while also giving me the ability to stay at home with my children after a marketing career,” she said.

Her connection to this community dates back to 1993 when her dad’s job brought her family to the area. It wasn’t long before they landed in Tomball after her mother researched school districts.

“Tomball stood above the rest for what they wanted...smaller district, highly rated and many activities for my brother and I to participate in,” she said.

Leslie was extremely active in school, having attended Beckendorf Intermediate, Tomball Junior High and Tomball High School. She is a 2000 graduate of THS and was a member of the Cougar Charms and played an active role in Tomball STAGE.

“I was in theatre production class, enjoyed many different roles in various productions, and also was the stage manager for our fall production my junior year and outreach officer for the drama club by senior year,” she recalls. “I also attended the state convention for three years with Tomball STAGE.”

Because of her creative nature, Leslie found a passion in the arts.

“My parents considered me their ‘free spirit’.” She took that free spirit and eventually landed in North Carolina. There, she was tasked with finding her path and it was an information session for the Art Institute of Charlotte that helped pave her way.

Her creative side was explored and the school provided her an outlet with like-minded students and professionals who valued creativity over lecture. She went on to earn a Bachelor’s degree in Fashion Merchandising and Management in 2009. After many “big-city experiences” following her degree, Leslie and husband Josh, decided they wanted a small-town life for their growing family so they returned to Tomball.

“It was important to us to give our kids the same experiences we had growing up,” she said. “There is something about a small town that cannot be replaced by big city lights no matter how hard you try.”

Despite the growth in Tomball, Leslie and her family have been able to make the most of their reconnection to her once beloved community.

“Tomball is special because you can have those unique small town experiences like a holiday parade, little league, city festivals, mom & pop restaurants but still have the convenience of the city of Houston with their big city fast-paced life.”

She admits that she was that kid in high school that couldn’t wait to leave and explore the world, but now realizes that returning to a connected community is what life is all about.

“Returning to Tomball also allowed me to teach my husband all the secret backroads and about the Mel’s Burger Challenge.”

Not only has she returned to Tomball, she has quickly made an impact with her business and volunteering with her son’s PTO as Vice President. She looks forward to continuing the same volunteer spirit when her daughter joins Tomball schools in the future.

“I grew up with a mom highly involved in our school. From elementary to high school, if we were involved my mom was right there volunteering and supporting us. I knew that if I wanted my son to succeed and his school to be a place he wants to go, I needed to be there supporting the teachers and staff.”

She has a passion for giving back and a passion for actively sharing her creativity with this community. From welcome back to school signs, happy birthday signs, to events around the community, one can connect those colorful yard letters to Leslie Johnson and her business, Tomball Yard Greetings.

“Every yard greeting we install spreads happiness and cheer in our area while reconnecting me with old friends I haven’t talked to since graduating, which was an unexpected bonus.”
