Learn More: Change of Learning Environment Process



Tomball ISD families will once again have the opportunity to make a change to your child(ren)'s current learning environment (F2F/TVS) for the third grading period, which begins January 6, 2021 and runs through March 12.

This process is open as of Nov. 30 and will remain open through Dec. 9. During that 10 day window, families will log in to <u>Home Access Center (HAC)</u> to make any necessary changes.

Please note: This process only applies to those families that want to make a change to their current instructional environment either in person (face-to-face) or virtual. If families want their child to continue in the environment they attended for the first grading period, you will not need to take further action.

If families choose to make a change, they must make the change **for each child** through the Home Access Center.
