Tomball Memorial High School staff recognizes and celebrates nearly 300 students for exhibiting its Campus Core Values.




## WES Creates Culture of Reading within School Community through Raising Readers Night

"Run for Your Life", an afterschool run club at NIS is for any girl who wants to share her love for running with others.


### DPES Encourages Reading with Blackmon's Bedtime Stories


