

The Tomball Education Foundation awarded 22 grants to Tomball ISD educators across 13 different campuses, totaling **\$62,009.09** to be used on innovative projects they submitted through the grant process.

The Tomball Education Foundation provides funds for educational projects and activities that are beyond traditional funding. Funds are used to facilitate student achievement and skill development, recognize and encourage staff excellence, and expand community involvement from individuals, businesses and civic organizations.

Since 2018, TEF has awarded over \$210,000 in grants to employees of Tomball ISD.

Tomball Memorial High School staff recognizes and celebrates nearly 300 students for exhibiting its Campus Core Values.




WES Creates Culture of Reading within School Community through Raising Readers Night


