## KEY TAKEAWAYS

Our board meeting agendas often include many items for discussion. While you will always be able to review the agenda, meeting minutes and video recordings of these meetings on [our Board webpage](#), this Board Bulletin provides key takeaways for our Stevenson community.

- 1** Leaders from the Student Services Division presented a brief summary of the annual Student Satisfaction Surveys, which aims to capture and measure students' perception of Student Services programming. Students from all grade levels are asked to complete surveys. Students nearly universally reported that they found their counselor to be friendly, accessible, knowledgeable and personable.  
  
The Division also surveyed one-year and five-year Stevenson alums. Survey responses from those contacted suggest that students feel more prepared for college than their counterparts in their first year of college. Students one year and five years from high school graduation are also studying a wide range of disciplines, from business and finance to social studies and secondary languages. - 2** As a follow-up to the board report on enrollment at the October meeting, enrollment at Stevenson (as of Nov. 1) was 4,496 students. This is close to the estimates made by our demographer DecisionInsite. Overall, enrollment continues to increase, and we remain confident in DecisionInsite's projections that enrollment will continue to rise in the years to come.
- 3** Assistant Superintendent Sean Carney shared that, as part of the annual tax levy process, a public hearing about Stevenson's proposed tax levy must be scheduled. This public hearing will take place on Monday, Dec. 19 at 7 p.m. at the Board's next regularly scheduled meeting.
