Happy Monday Families,

I hope you had a wonderful weekend! Thank you for sending your Scholar to school each day and reaching out when they are not feeling well and will be absent. Attendance meetings are still being scheduled for students who have been identified as chronically absent by the State of Michigan. If your student has been absent 10% of the days we have currently been in school, they are chronically absent. For example, if we have been in school for 30 days and your student has been absent 3 days, that's 10% of the time we have been in school.

Parent teacher conferences are coming up next week. A parent-teacher conference is a meeting between you and your child's teacher to discuss your child's progress in school. Parent teachers conferences happen in elementary, middle, and high schools. This meeting may take place as part of the regularly scheduled conferences held by the school each year, or your child's teacher may contact you to schedule a meeting at other times during the school year. This year, conferences will take place in the cafeteria. It is extremely important to arrive on time, as meetings will take place in 10 minute increments. Families should only enter the building at their designated time to continue practicing safety measures while socially distancing. If additional time is needed, you can work with your child's teacher to schedule an additional meeting at a later date.

Here are a few tips:

- Check your email for your invite
 Jot down 1 or 2 things you want to discuss with your child's teacher
 Take notes on how your student can be supported at home academically
 Follow up with the teachers after the conference via email.

Use rubrics as tools to provide a shared language with clear guidelines and expectations to provide a measure, adjust, and evaluate learning

DAILY ATTENDANCE MATTERS!

Here are a few practical tips to help support regular attendance:

- Make sure your children keep a regular bedtime and establish a morning routine.
- Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
- Ensure your children go to school every day unless they are sick and a doctor's note is required when student's have been out for 3 consecutive days
- Avoid scheduling vacations or doctor's appointments when school is in session.
- Talk to the principal for advice if your children feel anxious about going to school.
