
SCHOOL MEALS UPDATE

WHAT IS HAPPENING

The National School Lunch Program (NSLP) waiver that provided free meals to K-12 students due to COVID-19 is expiring before the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year.

WHAT THIS MEANS

School meals will no longer automatically be free to all students. Families will need to submit an application to qualify for free or reduced breakfast and lunch.



WAYS TO QUALIFY FOR FREE OR REDUCED MEALS

- Household size and income
- If you are experiencing homelessness, are a migrant, or a runaway
- Participation in assistance programs including:
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)

WEST BRANCH SCHOOL MEAL PRICES FOR 2022-2023

West Branch Local Schools offers a nutritious menu to students at a low-cost using state and federal funding. If you do not qualify for free or reduced-priced meals, they are available at the paid rate.
