Would you like to gain insight into the life of an Army Officer whilst gaining key leadership skills? The Army Officer Internship offers you the chance to experience the role for 6 to 18-months before, during or after university. Anyone with, or seeking, a place at a university or college, or who has graduated within the last 2 years, can apply. Apply by 31st December for Internships starting the following September. Army Officer Interns will be paid £18,000/year (£1,500/month).



Whilst this is not an active service role, you will still experience the range of training and opportunities available to a young Army Officer. Once the internship has been completed you can elect to remain in the Army, as a Reservist or regular Army Officer. Find out more [here](#)

Do you want to go to university and get a degree, or choose an apprenticeship and earn while you learn?

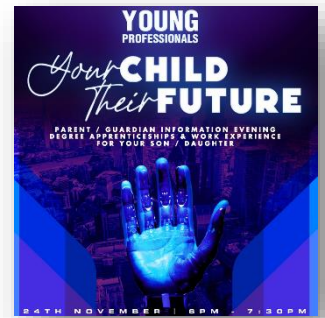
