## What Do You Do When You Don't Quite Fit In?

Feeling like you aren't a good match with your work's culture is stressful, but you can do some things to make it better.

### Identify the Problem

Company culture (values and beliefs) can be hard to understand. Take a step back and figure out what makes you uncomfortable. Find out "the why" and fix it.

### Do Something About it

Once you have an idea of why you don't feel comfortable, you can take steps to fix it.

### Get to Know Your Coworkers

It's normal to feel like an outsider at a new job for a bit. It's up to you to get to know your coworkers. This will help you feel a more connected. Adapt to where they are, rather than making them adapt to you.

### Talk to Your Boss

Be honest and explain how you feel and why. Give ideas for how things could improve. Make sure it doesn't seem like an attack on the company or the people, but that you're trying to gain understanding.

### Give it Some Time

Since the culture involves *all* employees, don't expect quick changes. Give it a little time—you may see some positive changes and you might feel more confident.

### Don't Let It Happen Again

Leaving a company once because you weren't a fit is understandable. To avoid it again, make sure that you ask the right questions. To understand the culture ask about things you care about before you accept a position.
