### **Part I: Position Summary (added):**

While performing speech language duties in support of student and parents, the employee utilizes bilingual skills to translate and interpret in the designated language(s) to and from English.

### **Part III: Major Duties and Responsibilities (added):**

Duties include providing proficient and accurate translation and interpreting through:

#### Student Services

- a. Communications with student English Language Learners that includes and is not limited to providing instruction to students.
- b. Delegated assisted screenings or assessments of language, voice, fluency, articulation, or hearing with student English Language Learners.

#### Support and Administrative Services

- a. Communicating, verbal or in writing, on behalf of SLP or administrator with parents and guardians of students.
- b. Charts, graphs, or other visual displays to communicate student's performance information with student and parents.
- c. Assistance with in-service training sessions or family and community education programs.

Performs other duties as assigned.

### **Part IV: Minimum Qualifications:**

Incumbents must have successful experience in working with culturally diverse families and communities, or have otherwise demonstrated a commitment to strengthening engagement of a diverse community and skill in communicating with a diverse population.
