

Complete Free & Reduced Lunch Form



STADIUM CAMPAIGN UPDATE

When the Northridge Athletic Booster leadership team was given the green light in August 2019 to work on fundraising for a possible upgrade to the stadium, no one could have predicted a global pandemic that would create unheard of fundraising challenges. escalating construction pricing, scarcity of products and labor and complete shipping chaos.

In what has seemed like impossible circumstances, the Athletic Boosters in partnership with the Northridge School District, has moved the project forward exceeding \$1.6 million in pledges and the school board officially pledged \$2 million toward the project to match the Booster's goal of raising \$2 million.

The Boosters and the School Board remain committed to upgrading the facilities to meet current and future needs in a fiscally responsible manner. The Board has created an Ad-Hoc Athletic Facility Master Plan Committee, which will review the current state of facilities, identify a potential long-term plan and vision, and make recommendations for phase 1. All aspects of the current plan are being reviewed in an effort to reduce the budget while providing updated facilities for our students. There will be opportunities in the near future for community, parents, staff and students to engage in the master planning process.
