Thank you for affording Red Top Transportation (later known as RTT) the opportunity to submit a proposal to the Scranton School District (later known as SSD) for contracted pupil transportation services for the upcoming five (5) school years. The current economic climate resulting from Covid-19 closures make it difficult to accurately respond to the SSD RFP as written. We have now operated most of the 2021-2022 school year, hoping to get a clearer picture of the future. Unfortunately, economic conditions have not significantly improved. The district itself has acknowledged this uncertainty in the revised RFP on Page 26, ITEM 14, OTHER PROVISIONS, Subsection (J). Factory shutdowns have reduced the availability of new school buses and new school transportation vans. Used equipment is extremely scarce and prices have risen as high as 50%. Everyone is aware of the nationwide school bus driver shortage crisis. Fuel and maintenance items are escalating on a daily basis.

RTT has provided safe, efficient transportation of special education students for the Scranton School District, the past 35 years including the last 2 years of pandemic uncertainty. We will be exercising OPTION 2, PARTIAL PROPOSAL as listed on page 3 of the SSD 2022 revised RFP. RTT will bid only on the type of vehicle necessary to provide special education transportation to the SSD. We will not be bidding on providing monitors for the vehicles. Previously when necessary, the SSD has provided aides/monitors to the students transported in the special education program. Most of the aides/monitors work with the students on a daily basis and can identify each student's individual special needs. The students are more comfortable with an aide/monitor which they are familiar. This arrangement has worked successfully in the past.

RTT will submit a comprehensive cost effective, ALTERNATIVE PROPOSAL. The "COST PROPOSAL" schedule is based on the last 5 years of actual number of vehicles utilized, and the actual time necessary to perform this transportation service. We will provide all necessary documentation required by SSD RFP. Any requirements listed in the RFP that differ with our current contract will be addressed in the exception section of the RFP. Most are not significant issues and can be easily rectified. This COST PROPOSAL would greatly benefit the district financially without compromising safety. Rest assured RTT has the knowledge, expertise and resources to execute this proposal.

If RTT is chosen to be the contractor for special education transportation we will pledge our continuing cooperation to the SSD. I believe our proposal aligns perfectly with the district's mission to provide better transportation service as cost-effective as possible.

ITEM 10 - VEHICLES PROVIDED Subsection (F) Page 24 of the RFP

ALTERNATIVE PROPOSAL:

RTT would ask the age restriction of vehicles to be negotiated. We propose to replace a percentage of equipment every year of the contract based on the actual number of vehicles that were utilized and compensated for. Hopefully at the conclusion of the school year, we will have a clearer picture regarding pandemic uncertainty and school closures. We can then establish an accurate count of how many vehicles are actually needed to fulfill the contract. This percentage of replacements can be negotiated yearly by SSD and RTT. We would also suggest working toward an average age formula, similar to the school bus requirements, applied to the vans. RTT currently has all the necessary equipment in its fleet, located in Central City, Scranton, PA, to fulfill the transportation of special education students, requested by the district's RFP. We have five (5) 24-passenger school buses, thirty-five (35) full size 8-10 passenger school vans, and six (6) 7 passenger Grand Caravans, with multiple spare buses and vans readily available on premises. RTT has a commitment from Rohrer School Bus Sales Co. for the guaranteed delivery of ten (10) new 2022 Ford Transit T-150 9 passenger school student vans and five (5) used Ford Transit T-150 9 passenger school student vans for the upcoming school year. All equipment we utilize was purchased new or one year old, specifically for the SSD's special education transportation program. Most have under 50,000 miles and none have over 100,000 miles.

RELATIVE DISCUSSION:

This subsection as written will guarantee the daily price for a vehicle will escalate excessively during the current economic uncertainty caused by Covid-19. I understand the district reimbursement is partially dependent on the age of the vehicle. Based on the state formula, the difference in reimbursement between a 5-year-old vehicle and a 10-year-old vehicle is only \$2.00 per vehicle. A new current year model vehicle compared to a 10-year-old vehicle is \$4.00 per vehicle. We also know that the reimbursement to the district from the state is approximately 30% of the daily cost of transportation. To replace safe reliable equipment at this time could add as much as \$45.00 to our daily cost to the district, per vehicle.

At this time, I would like to point out ITEM 14 OTHER PROVISIONS Subsection (j) Page 26 of the RFP stating: "With the uncertainty of the pandemic, the district will not pay for vehicles that are not needed either in total or by the day."

While I understand the district's position at this time, it would be financially irresponsible to purchase new equipment with the possibility of not utilizing it or being compensated. Our maintenance and safety programs are clearly documented and detailed in our Supplemental Information accompanied with the ALTERNATIVE PROPOSAL. I can also confirm that in providing transportation service to Northeastern Pa, including SSD, we have never had an "out of service" violation.

There are multiple guarantees to the district regarding equipment fitness in the RFP. ITEM 10 VEHICLES PROVIDED Subsection (a) Page 23 guarantees the district, that upon execution of a contract with RTT we must adhere to all conditions regarding equipment fitness and will be subject to inspections by PA State Police, PA Public Utility Commission, or PA Department of Transportation where applicable.

The district also includes in its RFP, ITEM 10 VEHICLES PROVIDED Subsection (e) Page 24 clearly stating the district retains the right to inspect at any time, any of the vehicles under contract, to ensure safety and contractual compliance.

ITEM 12 - FUEL Page 25 of the RFP

ALTERNATIVE PROPOSAL:

RTT will include in its daily cost per vehicle to the district, any increase in fuel prices up to \$3.99 (Three dollars and Ninety-nine cents) per gallon during the term of the agreement.

RELATIVE DISCUSSION:

At the time of this proposal, volatile economic conditions due to pandemic uncertainty, have caused fuel prices to rise daily. The average cost of fuel is \$4.50 per gallon in the month of May and has hit an all-time high, escalating daily. We propose the following fuel clause: "In the event that the price of gasoline rises above \$3.99 (Three dollars and ninety-nine cents) per gallon during the term of this contract, the SSD would be billed for

the additional fuel costs per gallon above the \$3.99 per gallon ceiling price." RTT would provide SSD with a copy of fuel receipts at SSD's request. RTT will determine the average cost of fuel at the conclusion of each month by dividing the total amount paid for fuel by the number of gallons consumed. The cents per gallon over \$3.99 will be added to SSD's monthly invoice. At the conclusion of any school year during this contract term, either SSD or RTT reserve the right to review and amend this provision if agreed upon by both parties. The language in the above fuel clause has worked effectively with every agency RTT has contracted with, it protects both the contractor and the school district from unnecessary costs.

ITEM 14 - OTHER PROVISIONS Subsection (j) Page 26 of the RFP

ALTERNATIVE PROPOSAL:

RTT would agree to this subsection if the district would include the following:

During any period of the 5-year term of the contract, should school (in person learning) be cancelled, and transportation not required for 50% or more of days of the approved school calendar for that year, SSD would agree to extend the contract for an additional year at the same rates as the fifth year of the contract. This will allow the contractor the possibility of recovering a portion of lost revenues, and would have no financial consequence to the district, as RTT would only receive payment for days worked and vehicles actually used during all years of the contract.

RELATIVE DISCUSSION:

This subsection, as written, places all the financial risk on the contractor. Prolonged school closures with no compensation would be disastrous for the contractor. Any lending institution would require a borrower to present a contract based on revenue guaranteed during the term of the contract. The district is unable to do this at this time as stated in ITEM 14 OTHER PROVISIONS Subsection (J) Page 26. I think as the pandemic uncertainty decreases, an agreeable alternative could be negotiated between SSD and RTT.

ITEM 15 - TWO WAY COMMUNICATIONS

ITEM 18 - TRANSPORTATION SOFTWARE

ALTERNATIVE PROPOSAL:

I believe that the above 4 items -15 through 18 listed on page 27 of the RFP are intended for larger buses, which are not operated in the special education transportation program by RTT at this time. We have requested information and pricing on the above items and currently we do not have enough information to include them in our daily costs per vehicle. In the alternative, it is my understanding that many PA school districts purchase

these items through state grants which are reimbursable to the district. The Contractor is required to allow the district to install the equipment in contracted vehicles. The district retains ownership of the equipment and the contractor's daily rate would not be affected.

RELATIVE DISCUSSION:

We have five (5) 24-passenger school buses. All bus drivers communicate in any emergency by cell phones w/GPS. A driver is instructed to never use a cell phone while driving. All these vehicles are dedicated to the SSD Special Education Transportation Program. They have a school supplied aide/monitor on board. We currently do not have, nor have we ever had, any of the items listed above on our vehicles. These items are not included in the proposed daily costs of our buses or vans. All vans we operate have a maximum of nine (9) students on board. Many vans also have aides. All van drivers have GPS capable cell phones. Monthly attendance records from driver's daily logs are maintained in our files. I believe the cost to outfit small vehicles with these items would be prohibitive, also at this time the pandemic uncertainty has limited the availability of these items. If it is deemed necessary, we would be willing to negotiate an amicable agreement, as more information becomes available.

ITEM 29 PERFORMANCE BOND Subsection (a) Page 29 of the RFP

A performance bond is not included in our daily cost proposal. RTT has been transporting special education students for the SSD for the past 35 years. The performance bond clause has always been waived based on our history of providing safe reliable transportation to the district. RTT respectfully requests the performance bond clause be waived.

RELATIVE DISCUSSION:

At this time RTT is unable to secure a performance bond given the current unstable economic climate. Our insurance carrier is requesting we receive a guarantee from the SSD that we will be paid for the minimum number of school calendar days. As previously stated in the 2022 revised RFP ITEM 14 OTHER PROVISIONS Subsection (j) on Page 26 the district is unable to accommodate this request. I have been assured by the insurance carrier if a partial payment for pandemic closures could be negotiated a performance bond could be secured at a reasonable cost.

ITEM 32 - INSURANCE Page 31 of the RFP

ALTERNATIVE PROPOSAL:

RTT agrees to include in the daily cost per vehicle the limits that are in our current contract with the SSD:

General Liability

\$1,000,000.00 - per occurrence

\$2,000,000.00 - general aggregate

Automobile Liability

1.000,000.00 – combined single limit

\$1,000,000.00 - uninsured/underinsured motorist

Umbrella Coverage - \$5,000,000.00

Worker's Compensation – Per statutory requirements. Included in worker compensation coverage will be employer liability insurance with a limit of at least \$100,000 for each occurrence and will cover disease and injuries excluded under applicable worker compensation law.

RELATIVE DISCUSSION:

The coverages listed above are what RTT has maintained with all districts we contract with, for the past 10 years. RTT operates only 24 passenger school buses and 10 passenger or less school vans for SSD's special education transportation program. I believe the limits in SSD's RFP reflect limits directed at buses with higher pupil capacity. The higher the pupil capacity, the higher the potential risk. We are currently pricing the increased limits at the time of this submission. Regarding ITEM 32 INSURANCE Subsection (d) Page 31 of the RFP, RTT agrees Abuse and Molestation Insurance coverage should be included in the contract if it can be provided cost effectively. As a relatively new coverage, our current insurance carrier does not provide this coverage in our existing policy. This coverage can be provided as a stand-alone policy. My insurance agent has applied for and has assured me he can obtain this coverage.

We do not have enough pricing information at this time to include these items in our daily cost. When the pricing information becomes available, we are willing to negotiate with the district to include these items into our daily cost per vehicle.



- c) Drivers are paid approximately \$15.00-20.00 per hour Years of employment for drivers range from 5-20years, average is 8 years.
- d) Attached loss runs from our insurance companies for past 5 years.
- e) Attached organizational chart of our administration and the duties they perform. We also use the Parents guide to Transportation Students with Special needs designed with cooperation from SSD and RTT. Attached is front sheet of guide, entire guide is available upon request (12 pages)
- f) Each driver upon hire is issued an employee handbook with procedures for performing their duties. Attached is front sheet of handbook, entire handbook is available upon request. (7 pages)
- g) Communication between Contractor and parents is minimal as the SSD Special Ed department handles most matters that arise. But our transportation director is familiar with most of the parents and can address any matters/concerns that a should arise.
- h) Red Top Transportation utilizes a Hiring Procedure Manual (Approx. 50 pages). All hiring procedures are covered in detail. Attached is picture of manual used (Manual is available upon request). Recruiting drivers starts with an advertisement in the local paper, A telephone interview is conducted and if they are interested, an in- person interview is set up. All background checks and clearances will be filed to the appropriate agency. - i) In the event of an accident a driver is instructed to pull safely to the side of the road and call police and transportation coordinator. The handbook has the proper procedure after the calls are made to the authorities depending on the severity of the accident.

- k) RTT does not have, nor has had any labor issues with any employees for the last 3 fiscal years.


RED TOP TRANSPORTATION - ORGANIZATIONAL CHART






